Maryland - Prince Georges County - Set.
on this 23rd day of March, in the year of
our Lord eighteen hundred and forty-
eight, personally appeared Robert W.
Shunter, before the subscriber, a Justice
of the Peace of the State and County,
aforesaid - and made oath on the
truly warranted solemnity of God
that negro boy - Lewis B. Jackson
aged about twenty ^{two} years - is, to the best
of his knowledge and belief, the same
negro that was liberated by Basil
Watton, by deed of Manumission, as
of Record will appear
