Columbia. The receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge. have granted bargained, sold and delivered, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said John Tyler. my negro slave Phebe by Ann Tyler (daughter of said John,) about six years old which said slave Phebe, Ann. I will warrant and defend to the said John Tyler his Executors, Administrators and assigns against me my Executors and Administrators. and assigns Every other person or persons whomsoever.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my name and affixed my seal this Eleventh day of May in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty five
