State of Maryland Prince Georges County to wit

Be it remembered that on this tenth day of Jany in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight before the subscriber a Justice of the Peace of the state of Maryland in and for the county aforesaid, personally appeared John Willitt a mulatto man aged about twenty eight years and made oath on the Holy Evangely of Almighty God that he is a free man, and was born so in the county and state aforesaid and received his free papers from the Clerk of Prince Georges County Court in the year 1829, and that by some accident unknown to him they were lost and or destroyed.
