To All Whome it my Concern— Be it known
that I, Margaret Morsell of Prince Georges County
and State of Maryland, for divers good Causes and Consi-
-derations me thereunto, moving, as also in further
Considerations of One Dollar Current money to me
in hand Paid have released from slavery liberated
manumitted and set free and by these Presents do
hereby release from slavery liberate manumit and
set free my Negro Girl named Henrietta after
she has served Samuel Morsell faithfully fifteen
Years for which term of years the said negro girl
Henrietta has been sold to the said Samuel Morsell
of the County and State aforesaid and then the
said Negro girl named ~~Henrietta~~ ~~is~~ ~~to~~ ~~be~~ ~~set~~ ~~free~~
to be free manumitted and Discharged from all man-
ner of Servitude or Service to me My Executors or
Administrators forever, — It is also further Agreed
that Any Children the said Negro Girl Henrietta
may have during the terms herein mentioned
if a Male Child he shall serve the said
Samuel Morsell or his heirs until he is thirty
five Years of Age — and if a Girl until she
is Twenty Eight Years of Age —
