Know all men by these presents that I Elizabeth Kirby of the town of Alexandria & district of Columbia, do hereby agree to emancipate & set free from my service my negro man slave named Isaac Humphries at present in the County of Prince Georges in the State of Maryland, provided the said Isaac Humphries shall within the period of three years from the date of this Instrument pay to me my exors or administrators or of us the full sum of two hundred dollars lawfull money of the United States <sup>with legal interest thereon from the date hereof</sup> and in the mean I hereby authorize & allow the said Isaac Humphries to hire himself and to receive from those who may hire him whatever wages he may agree to take for his labor; whenever the said two hundred dollars are fully paid to me my exors representative or of us here, then I will execute every more formal deed of Emancipation to the said Isaac Humphries that may be requisite to render more effectually his entire & legal emancipation -
