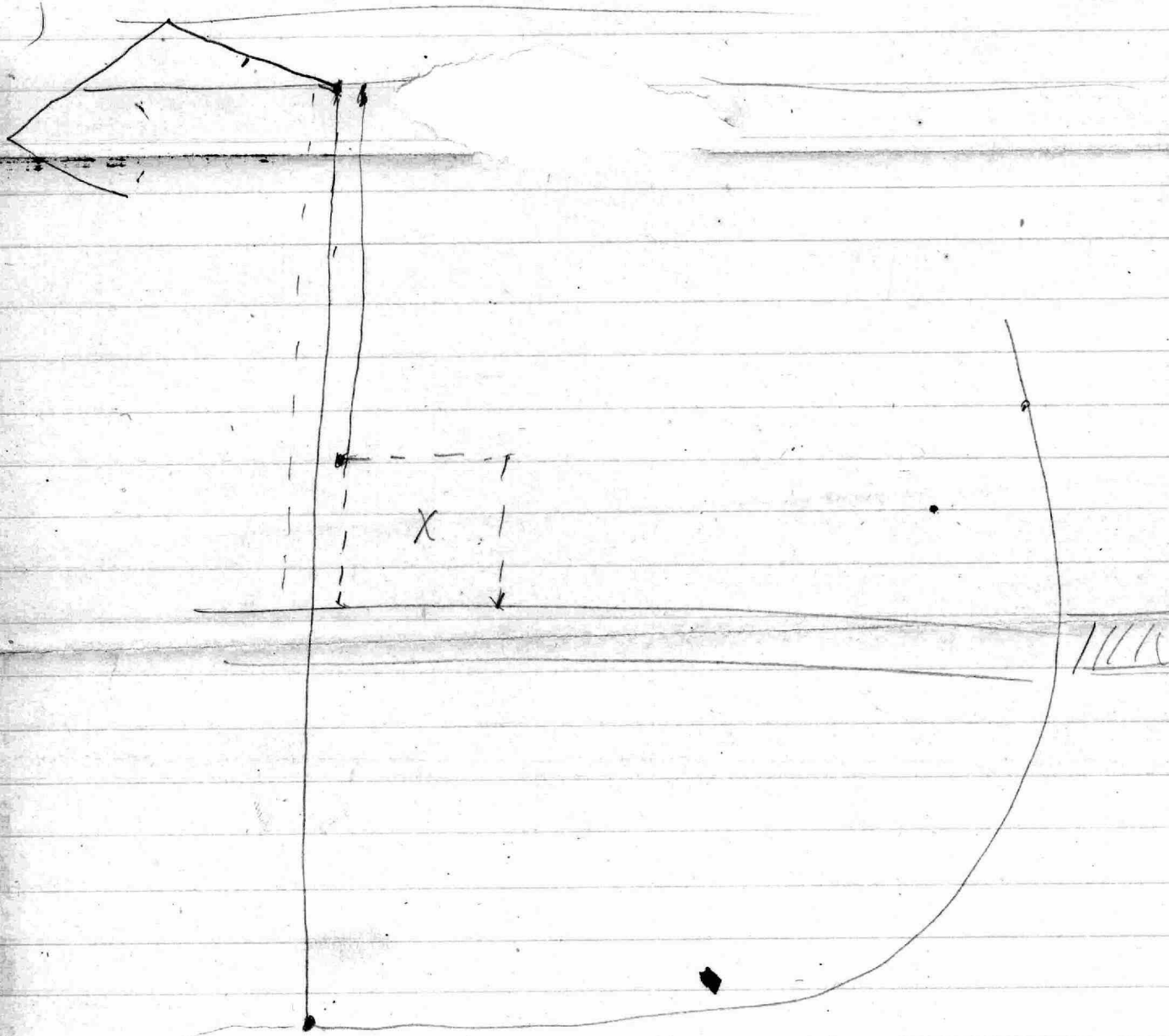

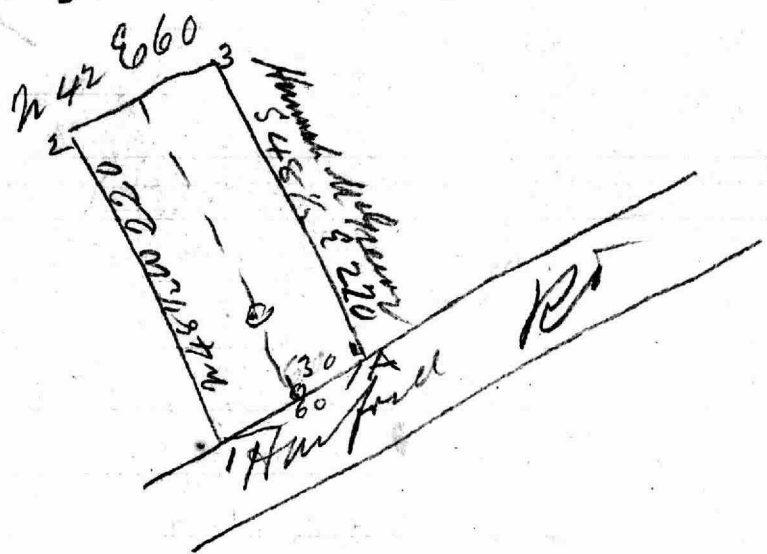

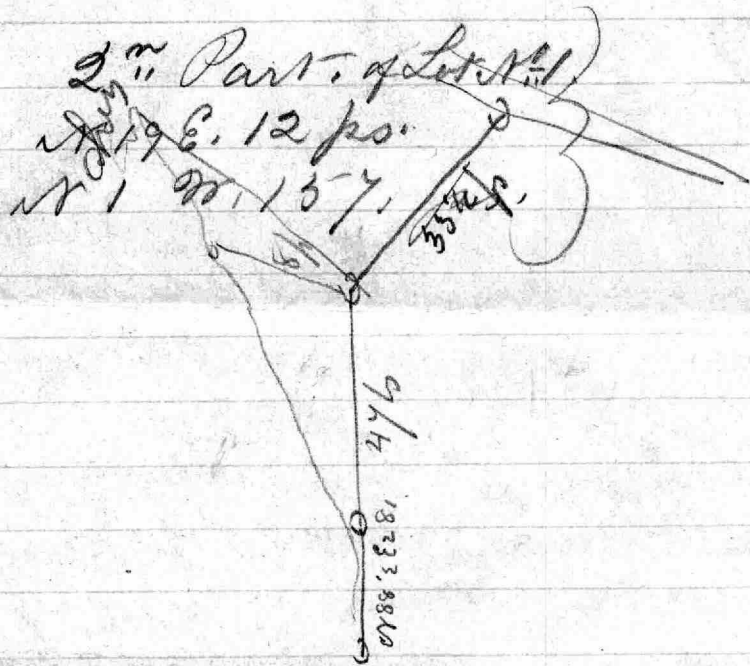

 Mr Tracy Elphie

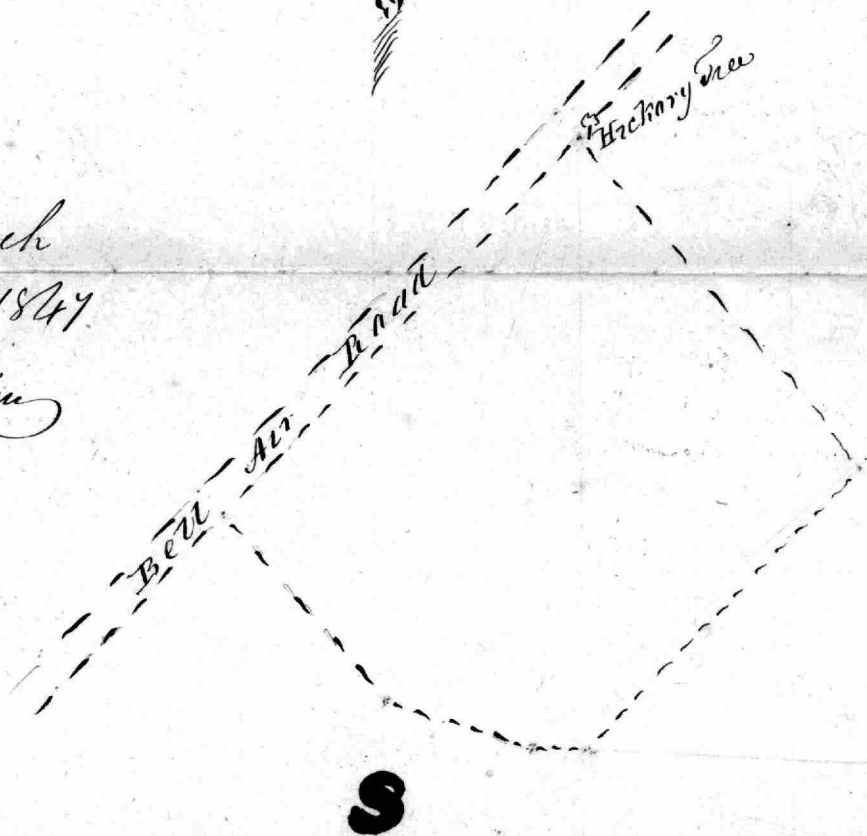

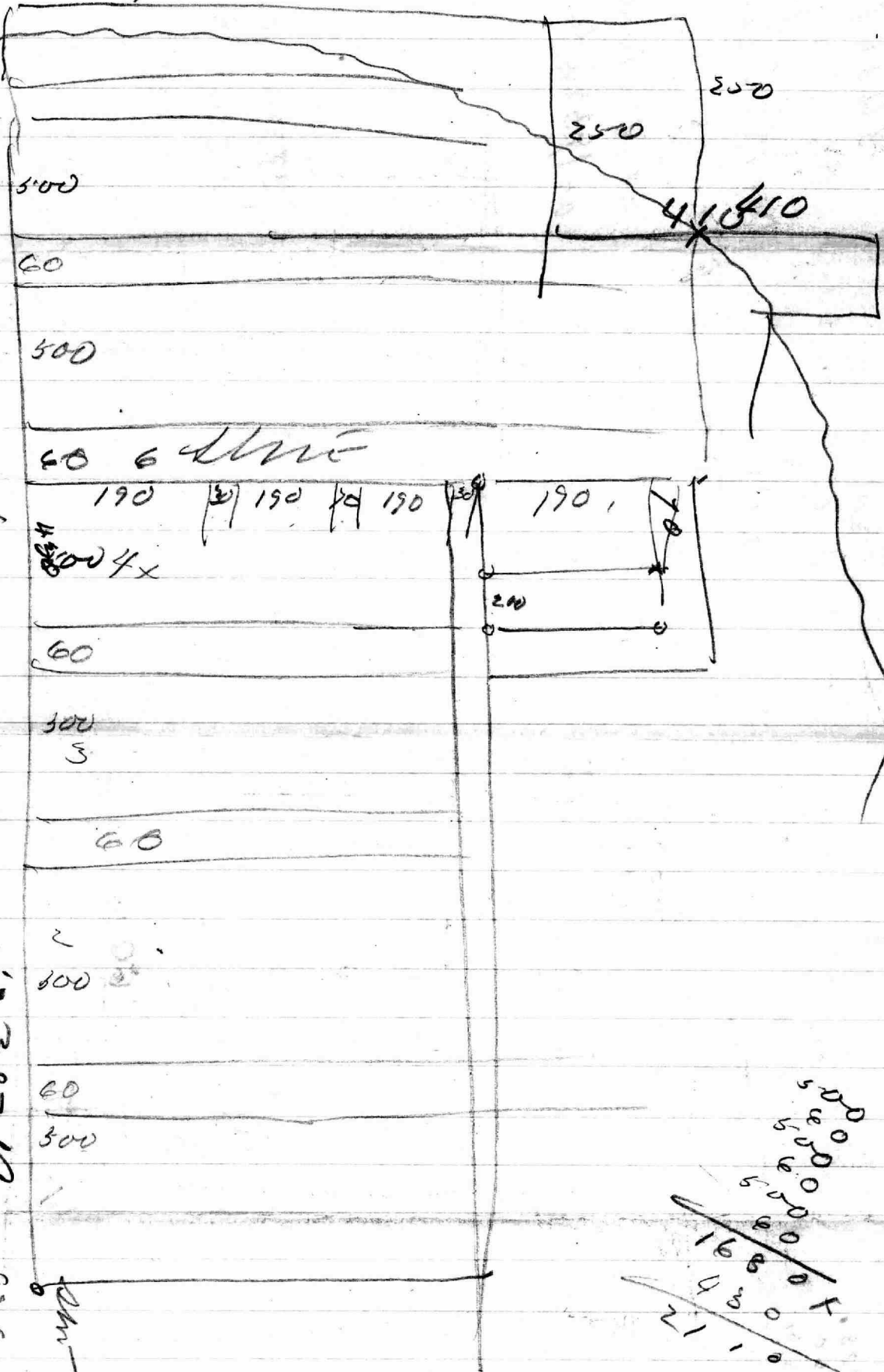

day of June in the year of our Lord, one thousand, eight hundred and forty four, between Gideon Fitch, and Mary Fitch, his wife, and Jonathan Fitch, and Margaret Fitch, his wife, of Jefferson County, in the State of Indiana; and Elizabeth Fitch, Henry Klinefelter and Elizabeth Klinefelter, his wife, and Ruth Leah Fitch, all of the City and County of Baltimore, in the State of Maryland, (which said Elizabeth Fitch is the widow, and the said Gideon Fitch, Jonathan Fitch, Eliza. M. 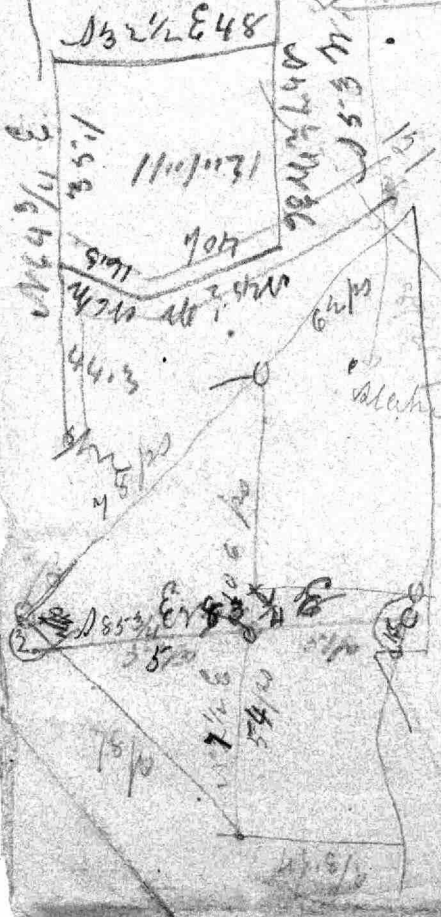
