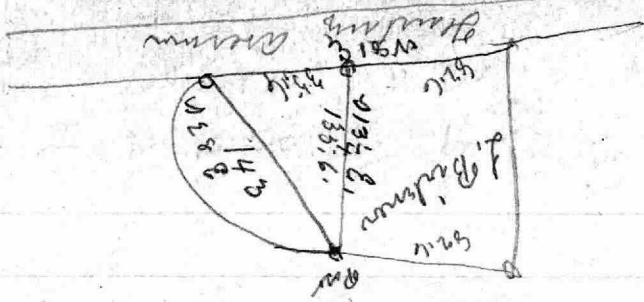

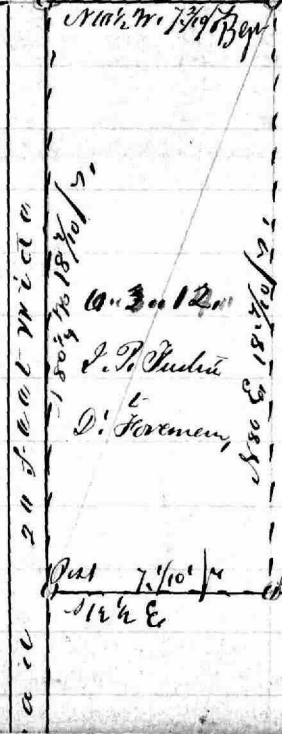

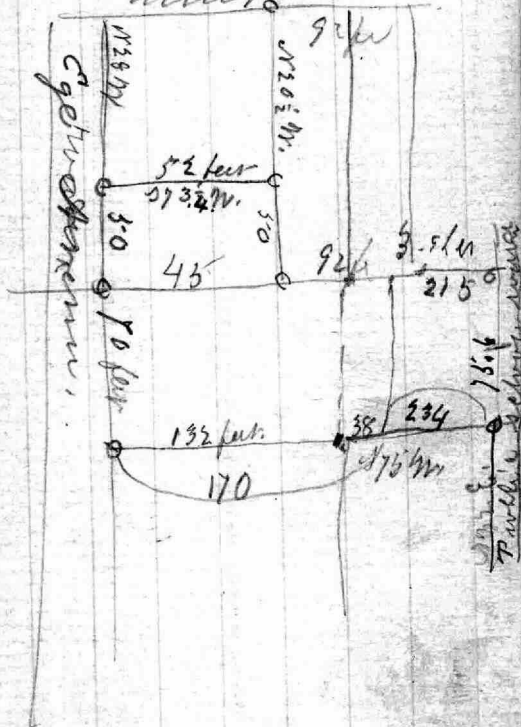

This cause standing ready for hearing and being submitted, the Bill, answer and agreement, and all the proceedings were by the Court read and duly considered. It is on this 5th day of June eighteen hundred and twenty two adjudged, ordered, and decreed, that the Complainant is entitled to the right of way as claimed by him in his Bill of Complaint in this case, and to have the same free and unobstructed, and so that said road shall not come within fifteen feet of the Dwelling House of the said defendants where they now reside.

It is further ordered, adjudged, ~~and~~ and decreed that the said road shall be opened and kept open and unobstructed and is described as follows.

Beginning at a stone (placed or to be placed) in the ground twenty seven (27) feet southerly from a large boundary stone standing on the North side of the said road, and at the line of division between the said Hahn and a certain Paige, and running thence westerly to a point fifteen feet from the N.E. corner of said Rest's Dwelling, thence

Westly to a point fifteen feet from the N. W. Corner of said dwelling. Then Westly to a stone fixed in the ground on the South side of said road as originally laid out & used, and thence Westly to a point nine feet Southly from a stone on the outline of the land of the Union Manufactory Company, and where said road terminates. Then Northly with the outline of the lands of the N. W. Company, Westly seven feet to the lands of the Complainant, and thence Eastly by lines parallel with the said lines on the South side of the road to the said boundary stone on the line of division between said Complainant and said Paige, and thence Southly, to the beginning, so that said road shall be at all places twenty seven feet in width.
