} Deed dated the second day  
of June 1821, for part of a  
tract of Land called  
} Macdow contained with  
in the following meets and bounds

to wit; Beginning for the same at <sup>three</sup> bounded white oak  
standing near a branch, descending into Winters Run  
being the beginning of the original Tract called Macdow  
and running thence North, North West one hundred and  
sixteen perches, thence West, South West twenty perches,  
then West by South thirty three perches and two thirds of  
a perch, then South, South ~~West~~ <sup>East</sup> one hundred and forty  
perches seven perches, thence East, North East fifty  
three perches and two thirds of a perch, and thence with  
a straight line to the beginning containing and  
land out for fifty acres of land. Also all that piece  
or parcel of land situate and lying in Harford County  
aforesaid, being part of a tract of land called Harri-  
son's Resolution and contained within the description  
following that is to say, Beginning for the same at the  
end of the tenth course of Harrison's Resolution aforesaid,  
being also the end of the North Ninety degrees  
East, sixty eight perches line of the said tract, and run-  
ning thence North, North West twelve perches, thence North  
West and by North, fifty perches, then North North West  
one hundred and six perches, then North Sixty six and a quar-  
ter degree East twenty eight perches, to the North North West  
line of a tract of Land called Expectation and thence  
with a straight line to the beginning with allowance  
of ~~two~~ two and a half degrees variations except the line  
calling for Expectation, containing and land out for  
Twenty one acres and sixty four perches of land.

Also all that piece or parcel of land called Cooper's  
Paradise and contained within the following meets  
and bounds to wit, Beginning for the same at the end of  
the Cooper's Paradise aforesaid and running thence South  
sixty six and a half degrees West eighty one perches, then  
South thirty seven and a half degrees East sixty perches  
thence <sup>South</sup> Sixty seven degrees East twenty eight perches  
then North twenty three and a half degrees West, twenty  
three and a half perches, thence North fifty three and  
a half degrees East, forty nine perches and thence
