Lot No 1

Courses comprising the Lot of ground Situate on the West side of Howard Street being part of Lot No 64 as designated on the ^{ground belonging to the} Plat of the Trustees for the Poor of Baltimore and County and described as follows viz "Beginning for the same on the West side of Howard Street at the distance of One hundred and eighty eight feet and eight inches southerly from the South side of an Alley Twenty feet wide as laid out by said Trustees (and which ~~place of Beginning~~ ^{place of Beginning} is designed to be at the North East Corner of the Three story brick house erected on the Lot now describing and running thence Southerly bounding on Howard Street Twenty three feet two and three fourth inches thence Westerly parallel with said Twenty feet Alley and bounding on the North gable end wall of the house erected on the Lot except adjoining on the South Thirty four feet thence Northerly parallel with Howard Street two feet and six inches to the North side of an Alley as now used thence Westerly parallel with the Out line of Lot No 64 fifty six feet and four inches thence Northerly parallel with Howard Street and bounding on the ground as heretofore conveyed by Frederick Baughman to Francis M Baughman in Trust for Mrs Ann Baughman Twenty ^{and six inches} feet to the Northern out line of the Original Lot No 64 thence Easterly bounding on said Out line ninety feet and four inches to the place of Beginning - "Subject however to leaving open the Alley as now used under the Main house of the width of 2 ft 6 in.

Courses comprising Lot No 2. Situate on the West side of Howard Street and described as follows viz "Beginning for the same on the West side of Howard Street at the distance of Twenty three feet two inches and three fourths of an inch southerly from the beginning of Lot No 1, and which place of Beginning is designed to be at the North East Corner of the Two story and attic Brick Dwelling house erected partly on the Lot now describing ^{and being the end of the first line of Lot No 2} and running thence Southerly bounding on Howard Street Six feet nine and One quarter inches to a Lot of ground as heretofore assigned by Deeds Bazar to Frederick Baughman on the 14th day of July 1819. and running thence Westerly

bounding on said Lot. and also on the northern boundary
line of Lot. No 65. One hundred and two feet to the Lot
of ground that was heretofore conveyed by the said Frederick
Baughman to F. M. Baughman in Trust for Mrs Ann
Baughman. thence Northerly bounding on said Lot three feet
thence Easterly still bounding on said Lot twelve feet thence
Northerly with said Lot. five feet and six inches to the south side
of an Alley ~~thence~~ left open for the accommodation of the
property owned by the said Frederick Baughman thence Easterly
bounding on the south side of said Alley as now used. Ninety feet
and four inches to the place of Beginning" subject however
to the use of the adjoining house on the north of the wall erected
on said Lot. now describing. with the free use and privilege
of said Alley in common with the adjoining property.

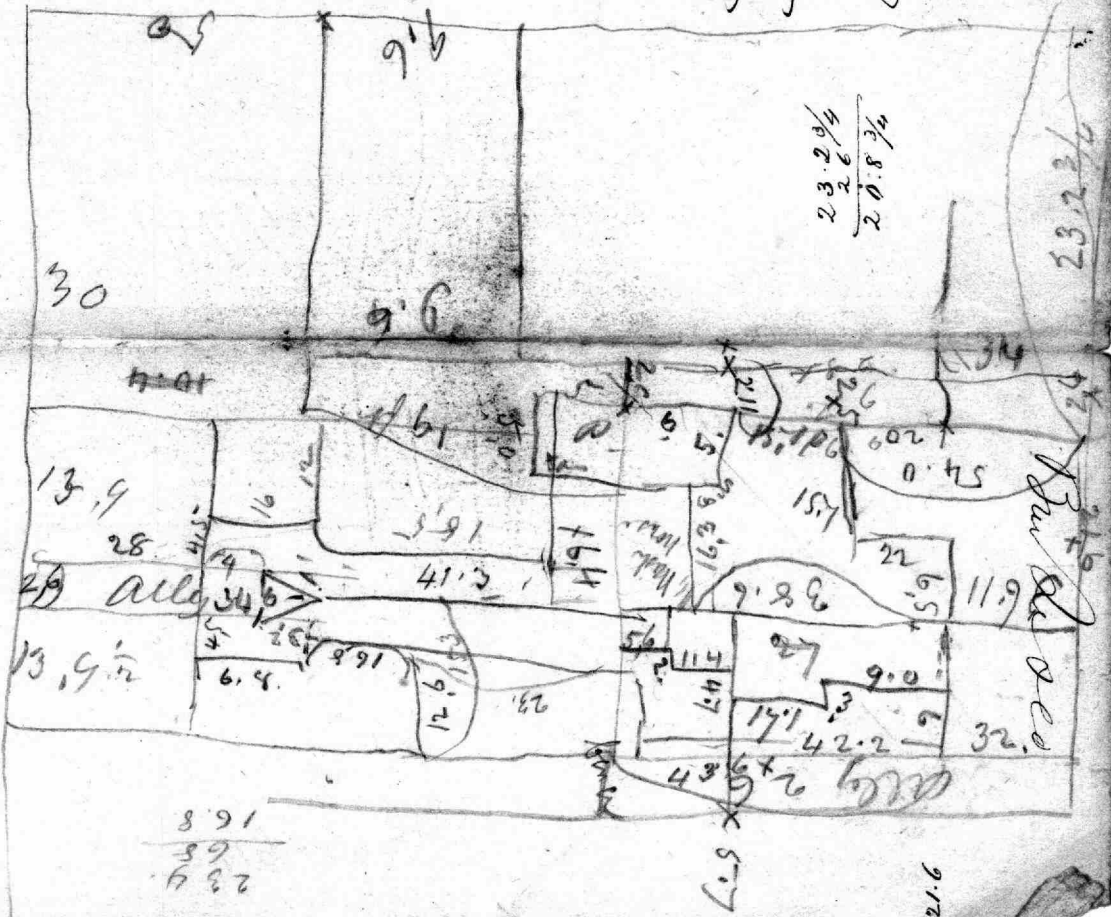
