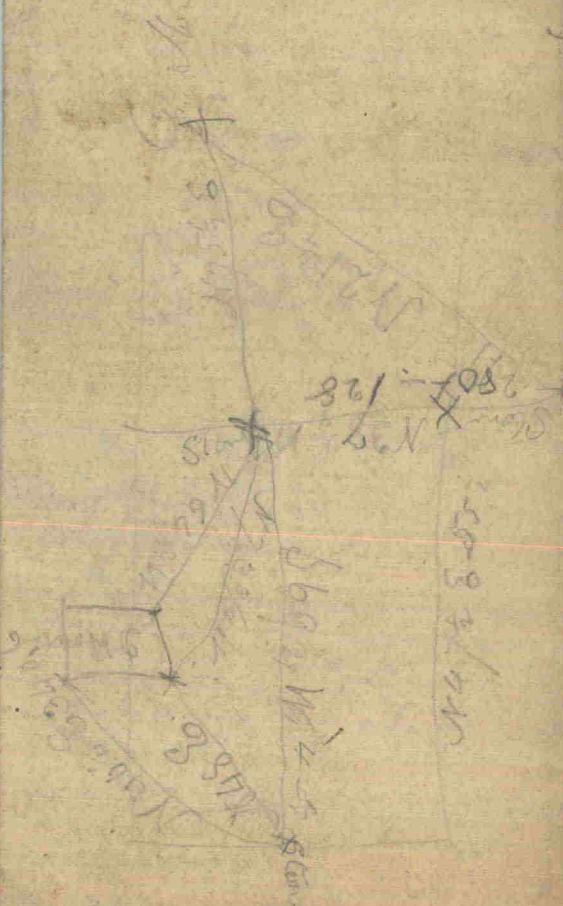




Plat of the Lots of

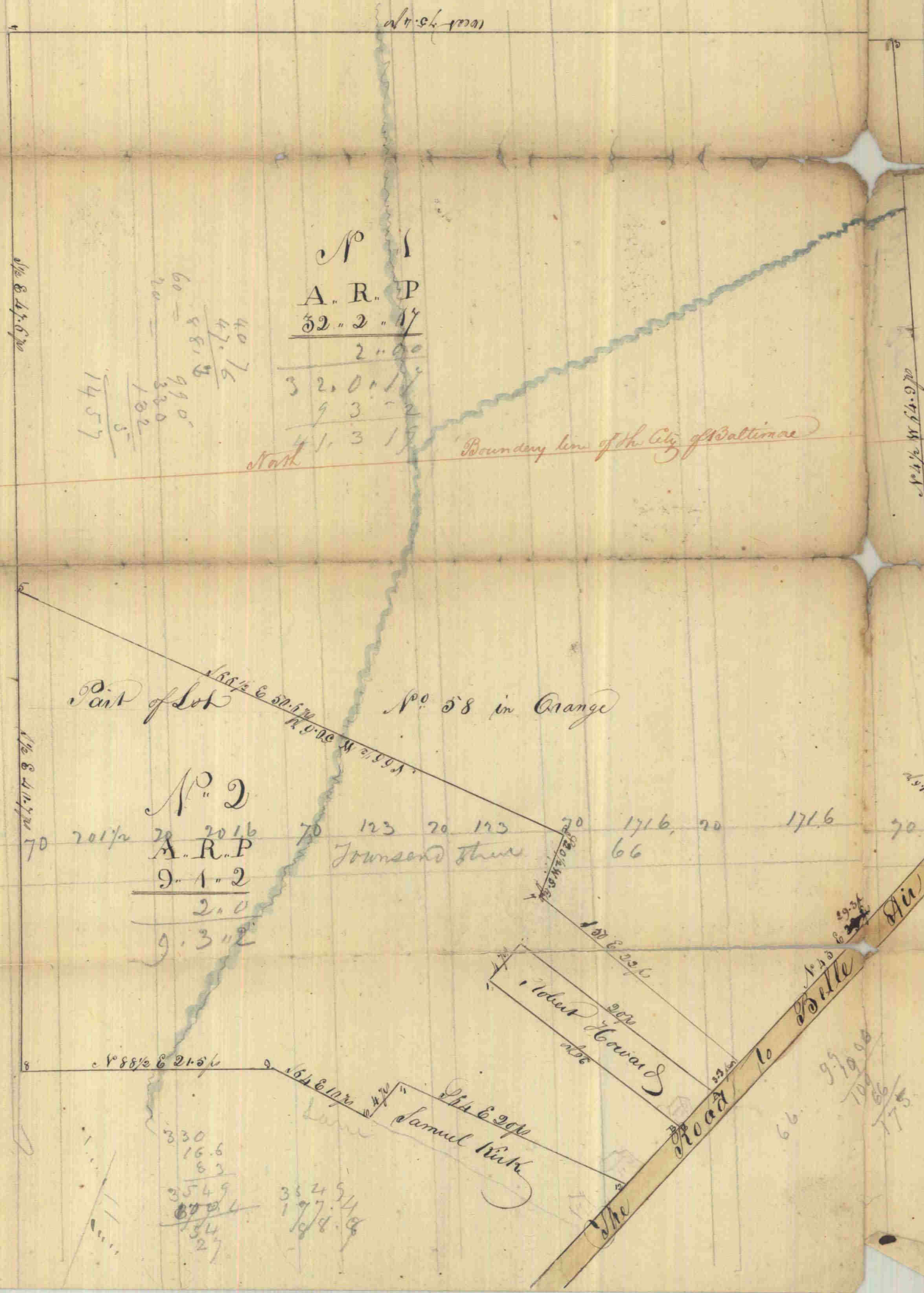
