"I beginning for the same on the North West side of the Baltimore and Harford Turnpike Road and at the distance of thirty eight feet and six inches Southwesterly from the South east Corner of Mr Chambers two story Brick house and Running thence South Westely bounding on the Baltimore and Harford Turnpike Road a thirty feet thence North Seventy four and one quarter degrees West One hundred and one feet to a stake now planted on the out. line of Hansons Wood Lot at the distance of thirty eight feet from a stake heretofore planted at the North West Corner of Frederick Ellenders Lot thence North fifty eight and one quarter degrees West One hundred and fifty one feet to the out. line of the whole ground conveyed by William Leach Howard to John Leach on the 31st day of May 1802 and recorded in Liber W.G. No 7 p 1490 &c. thence North Twenty one degrees East bounding on said out line One hundred feet to the South side of a Road or Lane twenty feet wide heretofore laid out by Mr Calhoun Trustees thence South easterly bounding on the South side of said Road One hundred and fifty one feet to the out line of Hansons Wood Lot at a point S 21st W 20 feet from a stone now planted marked R.O. thence from stone a Locust Post thence S 21st W bounding on Hansons Wood Lot 58 feet and six inches and thence by a straight line to the place of Beginning - It be and comprising a part of the Tracts of Land
