I David Gambel of Frederick County in the State of
Maryland for divers good causes and Considerations the
theerents moving, as also in further Consideration of one Dollar
Current Money to me in hand paid, have released from Slavery
libertie Manumitted and set free, and by these presents
do hereby release from Slavery, libertie Manumitt and set free
my negro Woman Agnes, being of the age of Thirty Eight years
and able to work, and gain a sufficient livelihood and main-
tenance, and her the said negro Woman Agnes, I do declare
to be henceforth free, Manumitted and discharged, from all
manner of servitude or service to me, my Executors, or adminis-
trators forever. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal, this fiftth day
of April in the year Eighteen hundred & forty four
