1834 came James Duke and made oath on

certain negro woman now present before me
named Sally Talbot is the identical negro
woman manumitted and set free by the
Will of Elizabeth Brown deceased, and
that said negro Sarah was raised in George
Town District of Columbia and is now aged
about thirty five years -
