On this 13th day of October
1836 came William Gwynn before the Subsoriber
Register of Wills for Baltimore County and with him
also appeared a certain negro woman named Maria
and the said William Gwynn made oath that the
said negro woman now present before me is the
identical negro woman Maria manumitted by the
Last Will and Testament of William Gwynn deceased
and by said Will to be free on the 4th of February
1828 - and that said negro is now about thirty three
years of age and was raised in Baltimore County.
