On the 20th day of December 1836
personally appeared before the undersigned Register of Mills
for said County. James Therr. and with also personally
appeared a certain negro woman named Nancy Wilson
and the said James Therr made oath that the said
Nancy was one of the Slaves who belonged to Thomas
Cradock late of Baltimore County deceased - at the
time of his death and was by said Cradock's Will set
free on her arriving to the age of Thirty one years, that
said Nancy is now about Thirty five years of age
and was raised in Baltimore County.
