On the 26th day of April 1837 personally appeared before the Subscriber Register of Mills for Baltimore County George Trickett, and made oath that a certain negro woman now present before me named Louisa is the identical negro woman named Louisa mentioned in the last Will and Testament of Peter Trickett deceased, and by said Will manumitted and set free on her attaining the age of Twenty five years, that said Louisa is the Daughter of Jenny and is now about twenty Nine years of age and was raised in Baltimore.
