On the 6. day of December 1837
personally appeared Mrs Elizabeth P Williams keeper the
Subscribed Register of Mills for Baltimore County, and with
her also personally appeared a certain Negro woman named
Tacey. and the said Elizabeth P. Williams made oath that
the said negro woman Tacey was one of the Slaves who
belonged to William C. Somerville at the time of his death
and was at that time between Twenty five and Thirty
years of age - and is now about the age of Thirty eight
years - and was raised in Saint Marys County Maryland
