On this 15 day of April 1841, before me the Subscriber Register of Wills for Baltimore County, came John Ridgely a - male Negro, and with him also personally appeared Susella Buchanan who made oath on the Holy Evangely of Almighty God, that the said Negro John Ridgely then present before me is one of the identical - male slaves who belonged to Charles Ridgely of Hampton, at the time of his decease; and that the said Negro John Ridgely has attained to the age of twenty eight years since the decease of the said Charles Ridgely of Hampton; and is at this time twenty eight years and five months years of age and no more;—And that the said Negro John Ridgely is one of the male slaves who was manumitted and set free by the Codicil to the last Will and Testament of the said Charles Ridgely of Hampton; and the said Deponent further saith that the said Negro John was raised in Anne Arundle County.
