Dorsey who made oath on the Holy Evangely of Almighty God, that the said Negro Sam Johnson then present before me is one of the identical - male slaves who belonged to Charles Ridgely of Hampton, at the time of his decease; and that the said Negro Sam Johnson has attained to the age of twenty eight years since the decease of the said Charles Ridgely of Hampton; and is at this time Twenty eight years of age and no more;—And that the said Negro Sam Johnson is one of the - male slaves who was manumitted and set free by the Codicil to the last Will and Testament of the said Charles Ridgely of Hampton; and the said Deponent further saith that the said Negro Sam Johnson was raised in Baltimore County.
