then present before me is one of the identical — male slaves who belonged to *Charles Ridgely of Hampton*, at the time of his decease; and that the said Negro

has attained to the age of *twenty eight*

years since the decease of the said Charles Ridgely of Hampton; and is at this time

one month years of age and no more;—And that the said Negro *Alexander*

Twenty eight

is one of the male slaves who was manumitted and set free by the Codicil to the last Will and Testament of the said Charles Ridgely of Hampton; and the said Deponent further saith that the

said Negro *Alexander*

was raised in *Baltimore*

County.
