who made oath on the Holy Evangely of Almighty God, that the said Negro *Cardine*
then present before me is one of the identical *female* slaves
who belonged to *Charles Ridgely of Hampton*, at the time of his decease; and that the said Negro
Cardine has attained to the age of *twenty six*
years since the decease of the said *Charles Ridgely of Hampton*; and is at this time *about Twenty eight*
years of age and no more;—And that the said Negro *Cardine*
is one of the *female* slaves who was manumitted and set free by the Codicil to the last Will and
Testament of the said *Charles Ridgely of Hampton*; and the said Deponent further saith that the
said Negro *Cardine* was raised in *Baltimore*
County.
