The following requests are made, in accordance with Maryland Rule 4-263 on behalf of the defendant in the above-entitled action, by his undersigned attorney, and

- a. The requests extend to material and information in the possession or control of the State's Attorney, members of his staff and any others who have participated in the investigation or evaluation of the case and who either regularly report, or with reference to the particular case, have reported to the State's Attorney or his office.
- b. The purpose of this requests is to obtain disclosure of material and information to the fullest extent authorized and directed by Maryland Rule 4-263 and this general purpose shall supersede any language or expression which might otherwise appear to be a limitation upon the object or scope of any request.
- c. Captions or headings used to separate paragraphs are no part of the requests but are for convenience only.
- d. Material and information discovered by the State's Attorney after his initial compliance with these requests, shall be furnished promptly after such discovery in accordance with Maryland Rule 4-263 h.
- e. These requests in no way should be considered a waiver of the information required to be furnished without request by the State's Attorney pursuant to Rule 4-263 a to the defendant.

The State's Attorney is requested to:

1. Furnish to the defendant (a) any material or information which tends to negate the guilt of the defendant as to the offense(s) charged, (b) any material or information within his possession or control which would tend to reduce the defendant's punishment for such offense(s), (c) any relevant material or information regarding specific searches and seizures (including but not limited to AFR inventory pursuant to Md. or information regarding the acquisition of statements made by the defendant, (f) any relevant material or information regarding pretrial identification of the defendant by a witness for the State.

I feel as though I am pretty strong with dealing with situations I read a lot and watch a lot of documentaries on incidents such as rape and other crimes. I really believe that is why I am alive today. When I was being raped, I didn't move, ~~and~~ did not cry or did not speak. As I said before, I was just thinking about them not hurting us.

Back to my family taking tranquilizers, I wanted to tell you they all were rushed to the hospital. They were released, but then a few weeks later, my mother had a nervous breakdown. She was in the hospital for ~~two~~ one month. This was too much for all of us. So, of course that was another worry in all of our lives. I wasn't fair, we never hurt

anyone and why was God doing this to us, I thought. One good thing about the whole incident was that my boyfriend was with me through everything. I really do not know where I would be if it was not for him. He was so supportive. I feel sorry for people that really do not have

DESCRIPTION OF PRESENT OFFENSE:

The Statement of Charges reveals that on 3-9-86 at approximately 9:10 p.m., Jacob Lerner of 805 Woodglen Place (Baltimore County) responded to his door bell and was confronted by a black male armed with a rifle. Forcing himself into the residence, the suspect was accompanied by two other black males one of whom was also wielding a rifle. At home at the time along with Jacob Lerner, was his sixty-seven year old wife Else, his son Lewis and his twenty-six year old daughter, Charyl who were all ordered to lay face down in the foyer while the suspects tied their hands behind their backs with telephone cord. Lewis Lerner was bound around the neck and told that if he moved the cord would choke him. After the suspects removed various pieces of jewelry from the victims and ransacked the house, Charyl Lerner's pants were pulled down and she was forced up the stairs into her bedroom where she was placed on the bed with a pillowcase covering her head. Vaginal intercourse took place a total of four times. At one point the pillowcase was lifted to expose her mouth and she was forced to perform fellatio on one suspect while another engaged in vaginal intercourse. Having remained in the house for approximately one hour, the suspects finally obtained the keys to the families two cars and fled. The police report indicates, however, that before their eventual escape, one of the black males returned to Charyl's bedroom and placed an unknown object (later determined to be a small perfume bottle) in her vagina. Once she was sure the assailants had gone, Charyl freed herself as well as the three members of her family who remained tied on the foyer floor. Subsequent police investigation led to the arrest of the defendant as well as Rafael Johnson.

STATEMENT OF DEFENDANT:

Indicating that he was reluctant to participate in this offense, the defendant contends that Rafael Johnson pressured him into coming along. He divulges that Johnson may have chosen the Lerner house to rob because he and his mother cleaned homes in that neighborhood. Once inside the dwelling, the subject claims to have taken Jacob Lerner into the kitchen to calm him and that he had no idea of Rafael Johnson's intention to rape the victim. He maintains that Rafael Johnson and the third suspect referred to only as "Lee" participated in the sexual assault while he remained downstairs. Altering the information he provided in a written statement, the subject states that he at no time went upstairs and was aware of the rape only through Rafael Johnson's bragging about the events that occurred in Charyl Lerner's bedroom. The subject claims to have misrepresented certain aspects of his statement because of pressure from police.

INSTITUTIONAL/PAROLE AND PROBATION HISTORY:

Interview with Juvenile Probation Officer, Louis Rosenback, disclosed that the defendant was found delinquent as to Assault (accidental shooting) on 7-9-84 and was committed to the Maryland Training School the same date. According to Mr. Rosenback, the defendant adjusted well while confined and cooperated while under community supervision.

PERSONAL HISTORY:

The following information was obtained through interview with the defendant on 8-23-86 and his mother and step-father on 8-21-86.

The third of four children, the subject was born in Baltimore, Maryland to the union of Elmer Maurice and Deborah Snowden. A factory worker, the subject's mother related that she and Elmer Snowden, Sr. divorced when the defendant was approximately age four because of the elder Mr. Snowden's lawlessness.

PERSONAL HISTORY: (Continued)

She suggests that the subject presented no behavioral problems at home and has never been suspected of abusing alcohol or drugs. Both she and her present husband, Kenneth Young, submit that Rafael Johnson had been staying at their home at the time the offense occurred and was thought of by the defendant as a big brother. Mr. Young, a Bethlehem Steel employee characterizes the subject as a "loner" who was more apt to follow than lead. He added that neither he nor his wife suspected Refael of any wrong doing because he was always respectful in their home.

EDUCATION:

At the time of his arrest for the present offense, the defendant was in the tenth grade at Overlea High School. According to his mother, he earned average grades and excelled in Art and Athletics. School records have been solicited and will be forwarded upon receipt if discrepancies are detected.

EMPLOYMENT:

Aside from working with his step-father along with another brief period of inconsequential employment, the defendant has basically been a student. His step-father provided him a weekly allowance that averaged \$20.


HEALTH: (PHYSICAL AND MENTAL)

Denying any physical ailments, the defendant recalls no exposure to psychiatric treatment, but claims to have been evaluated while confined at the Maryland Training School.

Describing himself as an occasional drinker, the defendant disclaims ever having experienced symptoms of alcoholism. He admits that his drug involvement began at age 16 when he was introduced to Marijuana and smoked the substance on weekends. Since then he has experimented with inhaling Heroin and Cocaine on five or six occasions but claims dependency on neither. The defendant contends that prior to the present offense he had smoked two Marijuana cigarettes.

FINANCIAL:

The defendant accounts for no significant assets or obligations.

EVALUATION:


Elmer Maurice Snowden, Jr., a seventeen year old black male awaits sentencing before the Baltimore County Circuit Court relative to Case 86-CR-2057; Rape, 1st Degree. The defendant is also awaiting trial in Anne Arundel County Circuit Court charged with Murder in connection with the 3-2-86 Armed Robbery of Romano's Restaurant. His juvenile record reflects one period of detention at the Maryland Training School that resulted from an accidental shooting (Baltimore City) and four other arrests which were either closed at intake or handled informally. Denying that he participated in the rape of Charyl Lerner, the subject asserts that he was manipulated into this act of terrorism by co-defendant, Rafael Johnson. Although he admits having illegally entered the Lerner home, the subject, in the writer's observation, fails to perceive either the horrifying degrading implications of this lurid crime; or the enduring impact upon its victims. Fortunately in this case, the victim, Charyl Lerner, was spared her life. Nevertheless, the terror she and her family experienced must not be minimized by any considerations in regards to sentencing the perpetrators.

RECOMMENDATION:

Accordingly, the writer respectfully recommends that the defendant be sentenced to serve the maximum penalty allowed by law.







That no longer happens, I've finally see that my life is what ever I make of it, not what my peers think it should be. I thought I would never get the chance to prove to my loving parents, that I was paying attention to all of the good morals and principles they tried to instill in me. My reluctance to allow my incarceration to corrupt my mind, has helped me obtain my Maryland High School Diploma, Associate in Arts Degree, and participate in various Self Help Groups. My institutional record is good, on rather impressive compared to my co-defendant. In approximately eight years I've been in the Maryland Penitentiary, I've learned how to be a skilled baker, cook, carpenter and other handy repairing skills. Surviving this long in such a volatile environment hasn't been easy to say the least, but it has built good character in me. It has helped me realize that, the crime that I committed is not only unacceptable in the eyes of society and our Lord, but should not go unpunished.

I now understand all of the anguish, pain and total violation my victims must and probably still are going through. If there was anything

I could do to undo what I must have caused, I wouldn't hesitate to do so. Not for the purpose of hoping it would help me regain my freedom, but for the purpose of hoping it would ease their burden of living with that nightmare. Not to mention the hope of receiving their forgiveness.

Ten years ago I was sixteen, nine days ago I turned twenty-seven. I'm absolutely positive that I've grown into the kind of man that not only society and my parents can respect and admire, but your Honor as well. I've already proven it to my parents and God, I'm so looking forward to proving it to you and society. I'm not expecting you to reward me with my freedom, because of my positive growth, that would be very naive and that I'm not. I want your Honor to know that I'm a man who once made a mistake, has spent the last ten years being reformed and is confident and able to return to society as a law abiding productive member.


