NOTICE OF ADVICE OF RIGHT TO COUNSEL

TO THE PERSON CHARGED:

1. It is important that you read this document very carefully, as it charges you with the commission of a crime.
2. If you have been arrested, you are entitled to be taken promptly before a judicial officer who shall determine your eligibility for release pending your hearing or trial.
3. If you are found guilty of this offense, you could be punished by a fine or by imprisonment, or both.
4. A lawyer can give important assistance to you in the trial of this case. He can help to determine whether there are any defenses to the charges against you or any circumstances helpful to you that should be brought out in the trial. Even if you intend to plead guilty, a lawyer can help you by developing and presenting to the court information which could affect the sentence or other disposition of the court.
5. You have the absolute right to hire a lawyer at your own expense to assist you in defending yourself against this charge. If the offense is one that is punishable by imprisonment, and you want a lawyer and are too poor to hire one, the State will supply you with a lawyer (the Public Defender) free of charge.

MEMORANDUM OF PLEA NEGOTIATIONS

It is hereby agreed by and between the State of Maryland by Michael A. Pulver and Leo Ryan, Assistant State's Attorneys for Baltimore County and the Defendant, Dejuan L. Butler, by and with the advice of his attorneys Gerald Vahle and Thelma Thompson, that:

1. The Defendant will tender a Plea of Guilty to the First Count of Indictment Number 87-CR-0516 which charges him with committing a First Degree Murder (Art. 27, § 616), for which there is a possible maximum penalty of life imprisonment in the First Count, Robbery with a Dangerous and Deadly Weapon (Art. 27 § 488, 489) for which there is a possible maximum sentence of twenty (20) years in the Second Count; and Burglary Common Law, Art. 27 §29, 30, 31) for which there is a possible maximum sentence of twenty (20) years in the Fourth Count.

2. Upon acceptance of the Plea by the Court, the State will Nol Pros the remaining counts in Indictment Number 87-CR-0516 as well as refrain from instituting criminal proceedings for the breaking and enterings which occurred on October 16th and 19th at 6124 Rich Ave.

3. This Plea is made pursuant to Maryland Rules 4-242 (c) and 4-243 (c) and in return for this Plea of Guilty the State will recommend at disposition of this case a sentence of Life Imprisonment.

4. That in return for the above recommendation by the State, the Defendant, Dejuan L. Butler, agrees to cooperate with the State

on the following terms and conditions:

a) Dejuan Butler shall fully and truthfully respond to all questions put to him by the State specifically, he shall disclose everything he knows about the murder of Josephine Maxwell on December 18, 1986 which occurred at 6124 Rich Avenue in Catonsville.

b) Dejuan Butler shall testify fully and truthfully at any and all trials at which his testimony is requested.

Dejuan Butler agrees to be completely truthful and honest in his testimony.

5. If Dejuan Butler should fail in any way to fulfill completely each of his obligations under this agreement, then this Office will be released from its commitment to honor all of its obligations to him. Thus, for example, if at any time he should knowingly withhold evidence from this office or otherwise not be completely truthful with this office in his testimony in any trial, then this Office will be free (i) to prosecute him for perjury, false statement and/or obstruction of justice; (ii) to charge him with other offenses, if any, that he has committed; (iii) to use against him in any such prosecution the information and documents that he himself has disclosed to this office during the course of his cooperation; and (iv) to recommend to the Court after such prosecution any sentence that this Office considers appropriate, up to and including the maximum possible sentence.

6. There are no other agreements, promises or undertakings between Dejuan Butler and this Office.

and members of the Baltimore County Police Department several times to outline the events surrounding Mrs. Maxwell's death. Throughout these meetings he was consistent in the reiteration of the facts.

4. The Defendant testified at the trial of Melvin Powell, a co-defendant, who was subsequently convicted of Felony Murder. Said conviction would have been extremely difficult without Defendants' testimony.

5. On November 10, 1987, Defendant received a (30) thirty year sentence for this offense.

6. The Defendant was (16) sixteen years old at the time he got involved in this tragic and unfortunate situation. He is now a seventeen year old child experiencing the rigors of life within an adult prison system.

7. Defendant comes from a loving family of seven. Throughout this ordeal he has had the support and love of his parents and four (4) brothers. Although the family is appalled and saddened by the circumstances surrounding this case, they still believe that DeJuan can be rehabilitated and lead a productive life if given a chance.

8. Mr. and Mrs. Butler have lost two (2) sons to the Department of Corrections as a result of this case. Lonnie Butler, age 21, also received a life plus twenty (20) year sentence for his involvement in Mrs. Maxwell's untimely demise. Consequently, they are hopeful that this Honorable Court will monitor Defendant's progress while in the Department of

Corrections and consider revising this sentence at a later date.

9. Prior to this conviction Defendant was a typical teenager who attended Hebbville Exploration Center with no criminal record.


10. The Defendant has already begun the process of rehabilitation by testifying against Melvin Powell (his co-defendant) at some possible risk to himself.

- A. Hold this motion sub-curia for a period of two years which will give him time to involve himself in some constructive activities within his assigned institution, (education, skills, training, etc.);
- B. Hold a hearing on the Motion at the end of that period of time, and
- C. Substantially reduce the sentence imposed on November 10, 1987.



MOTION FOR MODIFICATION OR REDUCTION OF SENTENCE

NOW COMES, the Defendant, DeJuan Butler, by his attorneys, Gerald W. Vahle and Thelma J. Thompson, Assistant Public Defenders for Baltimore County, pursuant to Revised Maryland Rules of Procedure, Rule 4-345 (b) which provides that:

The court has revisory power and control over a sentence upon a motion filed within ninety (90) days after its imposition (1) in the District Court, if an appeal has not been perfected, and, (2) in a Circuit Court, whether or not an appeal has been filed. The court may modify or reduce or strike, but may not increase the length of a sentence,

and respectfully moves this Honorable Court to modify and/or reduce or strike the sentence imposed and for his reasons states the following:

1. On September 22, 1987, pursuant to plea negotiations, the Defendant pled guilty to charges of 1st Degree Murder, Robbery with a Dangerous and Deadly Weapon and Burglary.

2. In exchange for the State's affirmative recommendation of life imprisonment the Defendant agreed to (1) truthfully disclose all he knew about the murder of Josephine Maxwell, and (2) testify fully and truthfully at any and all trials at which his testimony was requested.

3. The Defendant, in compliance with the aforementioned pled agreement, met with Assistant State's Attorney Mike Pulvar

and members of the Baltimore County Police Department several times to outline the events surrounding Mrs. Maxwell's death. Throughout these meetings he was consistent in the reiteration of the facts.

4. The Defendant testified at the trial of Melvin Powell, a co-defendant, who was subsequently convicted of Felony Murder. Said conviction would have been extremely difficult without Defendants' testimony.

5. On November 10, 1987, Defendant received a (30) thirty year sentence for this offense.

6. The Defendant was (16) sixteen years old at the time he got involved in this tragic and unfortunate situation. He is now a seventeen year old child experiencing the rigors of life within an adult prison system.

7. Defendant comes from a loving family of seven. Throughout this ordeal he has had the support and love of his parents and four (4) brothers. Although the family is appalled and saddened by the circumstances surrounding this case, they still believe that DeJuan can be rehabilitated and lead a productive life if given a chance.

8. Mr. and Mrs. Butler have lost two (2) sons to the Department of Corrections as a result of this case. Lonnie Butler, age 21, also received a life plus twenty (20) year sentence for his involvement in Mrs. Maxwell's untimely demise. Consequently, they are hopeful that this Honorable Court will monitor Defendant's progress while in the Department of

Corrections and consider revising this sentence at a later date.

9. Prior to this conviction Defendant was a typical teenager who attended Hebbville Exploration Center with no criminal record.


10. The Defendant has already begun the process of rehabilitation by testifying against Melvin Powell (his co-defendant) at some possible risk to himself.

11. Defendant has not had sufficient time to confer with counsel and prepare for a reconsideration hearing, wherefore Defendant prays for leave to amend this motion within thirty (30) days.
