On May 29, 1986, Ms. Yvette Dawn Martin, and Mr. Leonard Christopher Dowdy were about to enter the apartment at 7125 A Rolling Bend Rd., Balto. County, Md., 21207, when they were confronted by Ms. Martin's uncle, the defendant Mr. Delars Martin, who was brandishing a .38 caliber, snub nose, nickel plated revolver, and did fire the weapon at them, striking Mr. Dowdy twice in the left side of his face, and Ms. Martin in the right side of her head.

The apartment is the residence of Mr. Clyde Cobb, and along with Ms. Martin and Mr. Dowdy Mr. Cobb was returning home from the Social Services Office on Frederick Ave. when this offense occurred. Upon arriving home Mr. Cobb went to the rear of the apartment, whereupon he observed that an unknown subject had forcibly entered the home through the rear sliding glass door, while Ms. Martin and Mr. Dowdy went to enter the apartment through the front door. As Ms. Martin and Mr. Dowdy reached the front door they found it to be slightly ajar--approx. 1" out of the frame--and just as the two were taking precautionary measures prior to entering the apartment Ms. Martin turned and observed the defendant walking down the steps towards them, reach into a small bag that he was carrying and extract the weapon from same. As the defendant produced the handgun Mr. Dowdy turned towards the defendant, but not in an offensive manner, and the defendant then began to fire the weapon, twice striking Mr. Dowdy in the left side of his jaw, causing Mr. Dowdy to fall to the floor, bleeding from the wounds.

Ms. Martin then rushed into the apartment with the defendant following her, and as she entered the apartment she tripped over the doorstep, lost her balance and fell by the coffee table in the living room, but as she fell the defendant did fire the weapon at her striking her in her right hand and ear--Ms. Martin was able to raise her right hand up alongside her right ear at the time of the shooting, thus the bullet passed through

... her hand, through her right earlobe and lodged behind the right side of her jaw.....

When Ms. Martin regained her balance she ran out the rear door of the apartment towards
 a small wooded area to the rear of the apartment building, and as she looked back she
 observed the defendant still pursuing her touting the weapon, pulling the trigger on
 same but not firing any bullets... Behind the defendant Ms. Martin observed a second
 subject, but could not positively identify that person, however, when the defendant
 stopped chasing Ms. Martin she did watch this second subject leave the area with the
 defendant.

Upon hearing the first gunshot Mr. Cobb exited the apartment and then watched as the
 defendant and the second subject left the area in the defendant's black 1985 Chevy
 Blazer, Md. registration Y33071, heading eastbound on Rolling Bend Rd. towards Rolling
