Exhibit 1835 Between Edward McDonnell, of Frederick County, and  
State of Maryland of the one part and Cornelius McNulty, of the  
County, and State of Maryland of the other part. That for, and in  
consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars, current money  
of the united States, to him the said Edward McDonnell, in hand-  
paid by the said Cornelius McNulty. Now This Indenture. Witnesseth  
that the said Edward McDonnell, for and in consideration of the sum  
of six hundred dollars current money, to him in hand paid, to him  
by the said Cornelius McNulty as aforesaid, and for the better  
securing the payment thereof, with Interest to the said Cornelius  
McNulty, his heirs executors administrators or assigns, according  
to the condition of the said payment, and also in consideration  
of the further sum of Five dollars current money, to him the-  
said Edward McDonnell by the said Cornelius McNulty, in hand  
well and truly paid, at & before the sealing & delivery of these  
presently, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by the said  
Edward McDonnell, hath granted, bargained, and sold released  
and Confirmed, and by these presents, doth grant bargain sell,  
release and Confirm, unto the said Cornelius McNulty, his heirs  
and assigns, all that Tract, or parcel of Land, lying & being in  
Frederick County, and State aforesaid, being the Land as conveyed  
by John Walsh, and by Lewis Mottet (Trustee of James Moore -  
to the said Edward McDonnell the one parcel by the said John Walsh
