Be it remembered that heretofore to wit on the
12th day of July 1862 came the said Basil Delachumt
wife and others in Court here sitting by Grayson
Eichelberger Solicitor and filed in Court here the following Bill & Exhibits -

To the Honorable Madison Nelson, Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick
County sitting as a Court of Equity. - Humbly complaining Shew unto your Honor
your Orators Basil Delachumt and Elizabeth Francis Delachumt his wife, Thomas R.
Jarboe and Margaret Loretta Jarboe his wife, of Frederick County that in March in
the year Eighteen hundred and sixty two William Eagle of said County departed
this life intestate, seized & possessed of the following real estate, viz: of a tract of land
containing one hundred and ninety eight acres, two rods and six square perches of
land conveyed to him by St George Tucker, a full and particular description of which
will be found by reference to said deed, a true & certified copy whereof is filed herewith
as Exhibit No 1, which with all other exhibits your Orators pray may be taken as a
part of this, their bill of Complaint as if here inserted in words & figures: Also of a
piece or parcel of land conveyed to said William Eagle by The Bank of the United
States for forty eight and one quarter acres, excepting therefrom twenty acres conveyed
by said William Eagle to Elias Spalding by deed duly recorded in Liber W. B. D.
No 13 folio 108^o. One of the land records of said County - also of a tract of land conveyed
to said William Eagle by Thomas S. Davis & W. W. Claiborn & wife for one hundred and
fifteen and three quarter acres of land, excepting therefrom fifteen acres conveyed by William
Eagle to said Elias Spalding by deed as aforesaid - also of those pieces or parcels of land
conveyed to said William Eagle by Frederick A. Schley trustee as & for two hundred
and sixty five & one half acres of land - also of those pieces of land known as The Poto-
mac or Broken Islands conveyed to said William Eagle by Thomas W. Morgan Sheriff
also of a tract of land conveyed to said William Eagle by Michael Snuffer
and wife as and for one hundred and eighty eight and three quarter acres of land and
for a full and particular description of the hereinbefore recited tracts of land, reference
is hereby made to said deeds of conveyance, true and certified copies whereof are filed
herewith marked respectively Exhibits Nos 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7. - Your Orators further state
that said William Eagle died intestate leaving the following named children and
grand children as his only heirs at law, viz, Your Orators Mary Francis Delachumt
and Margaret Loretta Jarboe, daughters of said intestate; George W. Eagle & Syngus
Eagle, sons of said intestate, and Margaret E. Belt, who has intermarried with -
