Bowman who in virtue thereof possessed himself of the personal Estate left by the said testator at the time of his death and as your Orator is informed a. d. 1860. has applied the same to the discharge of other proper debts due by the deceased. And your Orator is advised that as the personal Estate of the said D. Wm Smith of D. deceased in the hand of his Executor was insufficient for the payment of all his just debts and has been applied by the Executor to the payment of his other debts. Your Orator and his other creditors yet unsatisfied are entitled to have their claims paid out of the real Estate of the said deceased in the hands of his heirs and devisees as aforesaid.

Exhibit B.

To the end therefore that the defendants herein after named may answer the several matters and things hereinbefore charged as fully and particularly as if they were to be interrogated and that the real estate of the said deceased or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose, may be sold for the payment of the claim of your Orator and of the other unsatisfied creditors of the deceased. And that your Orator may have such further and other relief in the premises as Equity may require. Wherefore please your Honor to grant unto your Orator the state writ of Subpoena against the said William H. Bowman, Jacob Coleman and Mary Coleman his wife, Samuel Coleman, Rachael Coleman, William Coleman, John Coleman and Catharine Margaret Coleman of Frederick County, commanding them to appear in this Court at some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein as in duty bound.
