Be it remembered that heretofore to-wit on the first day of February 1861 came the said Complainant in Court here sitting by Wm J & Chas W. Ross ~ Solicitor and filed in Court here the following Bill and Exhibits. ~

To the Hon Madison Nelson Circuit Judge for the third Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland sitting in the Circuit Court for Frederick County in Equity. ~ The petition of Michael W. Fort of Frederick County State of Maryland next friend of Eli Jacob Hamilton, Julia Maria Hamilton, Liza Ann Hamilton and Georgianna Hamilton infants under the age of twenty one years respectfully shews to your Honor that a certain James W. Hamilton died intestate sometime in the month of September in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty three and possessed of certain real estate situate and being in the town of Solon Frederick County State of Maryland, consisting of Lots No 29, 6 and 7, which were conveyed to the said James W. Hamilton by deeds from Geo. W. Jamney and Mary Jamney his wife to the said James W. Hamilton and Anthony Wright, and by the said Wright to the said James W. Hamilton, all of which will appear by reference to copies of said deeds herewith Exhibited marked Exhibits No 1 and 2 which your petitioner prays may be taken together with all other Exhibits as part of this his petition. ~

Your petitioner further states that the said James W. Hamilton died intestate sometime in the month of September in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty three as aforesaid leaving a widow named Susan Hamilton and the following children, his heirs at law namely, Eli Jacob Hamilton, Julia Maria Hamilton, Liza Ann Hamilton and Georgianna Hamilton, to whom said real estate descended, and who are all infants under the age of twenty one years. ~ Your petitioner further states that it will be for the benefit and advantage of the said infants, that the real estate in the proceedings mentioned be sold and that the proceeds of sale be divided among the said infants. ~ To the end therefore that the said Eli Jacob Hamilton, Julia Maria Hamilton, Liza Ann Hamilton and Georgianna Hamilton may answer the several matters and things hereinbefore stated as fully and as particularly as if they were hereinafter repeated and they were thereunto specially interrogated and that the real estate in the proceedings mentioned be sold and that your petitioner may have such further and other relief as the nature and equity of this case may require. ~

May it please your Honor to grant unto your petitioner the writ of Subpoena against the said Eli Jacob Hamilton, Julia Maria Hamilton, Liza Ann Hamilton and Georgianna Hamilton of Frederick County State of Maryland, commanding them to appear in this Court at some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and abide by and for four such scores as may be passed therein. ~ And as in duty bound I am
