The Bill of Complaint of versus Avery Ruth
and Ruth respectfully state that General Suckett late of
Frederick County deceased by her last will and testament
Bill duly executed to pass her estate devised and bequeathed
to her nephew two hundred dollars and did further devise
and bequeath all the rest and residue of her estate real and
personal excepting her servants to her three daughters
to wit Mary George Suckett Caroline Suckett and Ann
Elizabeth Suckett in equal portions share and share alike
the same to be left in the hands of her executors to be paid
to them by her said executors as they may think they need it
for the support of her negro slave David and in the
event of the death of any of said legatees her portion to be
divided among her surviving sisters your Complainants
Charge that the said testator by his will manumitted
your Complainants David and her niece Fanny and her
niece Ruth and her nephew at her death and further
manumitted her servant Charles aged about 15 at the
age of 21 years to be bound only by her executors until
he attains that age and his benefits to be paid to him
and also manumitted her servant George aged about seven
years to remain with his mother until he is sixteen years
old then to be hired out until the age of 21 then to be free
and his earnings to be paid to him and your Complainants
further state that the said General Suckett constituted
Mary B. Suckett to be executor of her said last will all
of which matters were once fully and at large appear
reference being had to a certified Copy of said will dated
on fourth day of March 1856 and herewith exhibiting marked
Exhibit N^o 1 which with all other exhibits hereinafter produced
your Complainants pray may be taken as a part of this
