 dying without making out letters testamentary on said
 Will, Letters of Administration with the will annexed
 of Anna Lockett deceased were granted by the Appellate Court
 for Frederick County to Sebastian Brunsberg who has entered
 upon the duties of his office as will be seen by the
 letters of exemplification herewith exhibited marked
 N^o 3 Your Complainant further charge that said testatrix
 one of said devisees and legatees died before the said
 testatrix and that the portion devised to her devised
 upon her surviving sister that Ann Lockett another
 of said devisees and legatees has since become insane
 and is now in the Maryland Hospital and that a
 Committee of her person and estate has been appointed
 and that Luquida Lockett and Mary B. Lockett the other
 devisees in Montgomery County, Your Complainant charge
 that the said Anna Lockett at the time of her death
 died possessed of a small amount of personal property
 exclusive of her negroes and did seize and possess
 of one undivided portion of in and to a part of tract
 of land situate in the County and State aforesaid called
 The Reserve on Lockett's Army Negroes Containing
 One hundred and twenty acres of land heretofore conveyed
 by Samuel Lockett and others to Charles H. Lockett
 and the testatrix the said Anna Lockett as will be
 seen by a certified copy of said deed herewith
 exhibited marked Exhibit N^o 3. Your Complainant
 charge that the said Anna Lockett died much indebted
 that the personal estate exclusive of said negroes is
 insufficient to pay the debts due and owing by the said
 Anna Lockett and that the personal estate of said
 Anna Lockett exclusive of her negroes managed
 by her wife and that the Real Estate of which the
 said Anna Lockett died seized and possessed are
 sufficient to pay all the debts due and owing by said
 Anna Lockett without resorting to the negroes Your
 Complainant whose freedom commenced at the death
 of said testatrix or to Charles and George Negroes
 whose periods of freedom had not arrived at the time
 of filing this Bill of Complaint. Your Complainant
 further charge that the creditors of said Anna Lockett
 deceased are urgent for payment and they have well grounded
 apprehensions that they may be seized and sold for the
 payment of the debts of said testatrix. In Render Consider
 ation whereof and for as much as Your Complainant are
 remediless in the premises by the strict rules of the Common
 Law and only relievable in a Court of Equity when matters
