Be it remembered that heretofore, to wit: on the 15th day of December, in the
year of our Lord, One thousand Eight hundred and sixty nine came the said Samuel
Dutrow into Court here sitting as a Court of Equity, by his Solicitors Messrs H & C. Ross
Esquires, and filed here the following Bill of Complaint, with the Exhibits
therein mentioned: ~

To the Honorable the Judges of the Sixth Judicial Circuit of the State
of Maryland, sitting in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court
of Equity. ~

The Bill of Complaint of Samuel Dutrow of Frederick County, State
of Maryland in behalf of himself and all other Creditors of Grafton Duwall
late of said County deceased who will come in and contribute to the expenses
of this Bill, respectfully shows to your Honors. That a certain Grafton
Duwall late of Frederick County, deceased, was in his life time indebted to
your Complainant in the sum of One thousand dollars, on his promissory note
dated November 16th 1859, payable twelve months after date, with interest from
date, the interest being paid on said note to November the 19th 1867, and was further
indebted to your Complainant in the sum of Eight hundred dollars on his promissory
note dated on the Eighteenth day of December 1866 payable Twelve Months after date
with interest from date, the interest being paid on said Note to December 18th 1867,
and was further indebted to your Complainant in the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars
on his promissory note dated on the Eleventh day of October in the year Eighteen hun-
dred and sixty five, payable twelve months after date with interest from
date, the interest being paid on said Note to the Eleventh day of October 1867.

And was further indebted to your Complainant in the sum of Fifteen hundred
dollars, on his promissory Note dated on the Fourteenth day of January, in
the year Eighteen hundred and sixty eight, payable Twelve Months after
date with interest from date, All of which will more fully and at large
appear by reference to said Promissory Notes herewith filed marked
Exhibits Nos. 1, 2, 3, & 4. which your Complainant prays together with all
other Exhibits hereinafter filed may be taken and considered as part of this
his Bill of Complaint, the same as if set forth in words and figures. ~

Your Complainant further charges that said Grafton Duwall died some
time in the fall of the year Eighteen hundred and sixty eight, having previous-
ly executed his last will and testament, and appointed Arthur Delashanutt
and Benjamin W Duwall his Executors, which said Will was attested but by
two witnesses - and was only admitted to Probate by the Orphan's Court for
Frederick County, as a good and sufficient will to pass personal property, and that
letters testamentary thereon were granted by said Orphan's Court to said Delash-
anutt and Duwall the Executors thereof. As will appear by reference to the Certified
Copy of said Will, and letters of Exemplification thereon, herewith Exhibited
marked Exhibits Nos 5 & 6. ~

Your Complainant further charges that the said Grafton Duwall died as aforesaid
