Bill of Complaint

The Bill of Complaint of Martha E. Wilcox in her own behalf, and of Lempe E. Wilcox, Harry E. Wilcox and Hattie R. Wilcox infants under 21 years of age, by the said Martha E. Wilcox, as their natural Guardian and per chem am, all of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, respectfully represents unto your Honors that on the second day of February, in the year Eighteen hundred and eighty three, a certain John Wilcox of Frederick County aforesaid departed this life intestate, seized and possessed of valuable real estate situated in said Frederick County and fully described in deeds conveying the same to the said John Wilcox, duly certified copies of which as recorded among the Land records of Frederick County, are herewith filed, marked Exhibits Nos 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, less that described in Exhibit No. 10, which Exhibits with all other exhibits by these Complainants herewith filed it is prayed may be taken and considered as a part hereof as fully as if herein inserted in words and figures.

These Complainants further represent and charge that the said John Wilcox left surviving him as his widow your Complainant Martha E. Wilcox and the following named children and grand children as his heirs at Law, to wit, a son Rufus Wilcox, whose wife's name is Annie Wilcox; a daughter Annie Hiteshew, whose husbands name is Philip L. Hiteshew, a daughter Maggie A. Wray whose husbands name is William H. Wray, Jr., a daughter Laura Jane Dixon, whose husbands name is Frank Dixon; a son Charles Wilcox; a daughter Lempe E. Wilcox; a daughter Hattie R. Wilcox; a son Harry Edward Wilcox and as grand children the following named children and heirs at Law of Anna Mary Getzendanner, a deceased daughter of the said John Wilcox, to wit, Florence Bergan, whose husbands name is Charles Bergan, Estella Correa, whose husbands name is John Correa and Minnie Getzendanner, to which children and grand children said Real estate described in the Exhibits aforesaid descended and vested in as tenants in common subject to the power right of your Complainant Martha E.
