May it please Your Honor to grant unto your complainants the Writ of Subpoena directed to the said John Stem who is an infant defendant residing in Frederick County, and also to said David Derr and said John D Keller, Administrators of William Keller deceased the adult defendants residing in Frederick County - commanding them and each of them to be and appear in this Court on some certain day to be named therein to answer the premises, and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein -

At the request of John Main the following Deed is recorded July 29th. 1876.

This Deed made this first day of July, in the Year Eighteen hundred and seventy six, (Witnesseth, that whereas Daniel Getzendammer, late of Frederick County, deceased, in his life time, did bargain and sell to John Main part of a tract of land situate in Frederick County, and the said Daniel Getzendammer having died without executing a deed of conveyance for the same; and whereas the said John Main has since the death of the said Daniel Getzendammer paid to Edward T. Getzendammer paid to Edward T. Getzendammer and Daniel Getzendammer Executors, of the last will of said deceased, the full purchase money due and owing on said land. Now therefore in consideration of the premises and in obedience to an order of the Orphans Court for Frederick County, bearing date May 29th 1876, we the said Edward T. Getzendammer and Daniel Getzendammer Executors of the last will of Daniel Getzendammer late of Frederick County, deceased, do grant unto John Main all the right and title of Daniel Getzendammer, dec'd in and to the lot of ground sold as aforesaid, said lot being part of a tract of land called "The Runway on Stony Spring", and part of a tract called "Chestnut Hill" or be it any other name whatever, situate in Frederick County, and adjoining the lands of Elias Post, Catharine Smith, F.M. Getzendammer and others and containing five acres of land, more or less, together with all the rights, uses and privileges of water, which the said Daniel Getzendammer deceased, possessed for the use of the Mill upon the land hereby conveyed; the land hereby conveyed being part of the land which the said Daniel Getzendammer deceased, obtained by the last will of John Getzendammer, bearing date October 24th 1833 and recorded in the Office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County, in Liber L. M. E. No. 2 - folio 604 &c
