This Mortgage made this Sixth day of September in the Year Eighteen hundred and Seventy Six by us John Main and his wife Martha Main Witnisseth, Whereas William Keller and Daniel Dew are the securities for the said John Main on a note dated on the 26th day of May 1876 drawn for Nine hundred dollars and payable at the Franklin Savings Bank of Frederick Six Months after date. Now therefore to indemnify and save harmless from all loss costs and damages which the said William Keller and Daniel Dew or either of them may sustain as the securities Exhibitors of the said John Main on the aforesaid Note or any renewal thereof we the said John Main and his wife Martha Main do grant in fee simple unto the said William Keller and Daniel Dew. All the following described tract or parcel of ground situate in Frederick County State of Maryland and being all the Land with the rights thereto belonging which the said John Main obtained from Edward P. Getzendamer and Daniel Getzendamer Executors of the Last Will of Daniel Getzendamer deceased by deed bearing date July 1st 1876 and recorded in Liber T. G. No. 5: folio 643, One of the Land Records of Frederick County.
