Bill of Complaint

This Deed made this sixth day of May in the year Eighteen hundred and ninety nine by us, Mary G. Brown, formerly Mary G. Crampton and Edward P. Brown her husband of Wood County, in the State of West Virginia. Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of sixteen hundred dollars (\$1600.00) to us cash in hand paid by Benjamin P. Crampton of Frederick County, Maryland, at and before the execution and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Mary G. Brown and Edward P. Brown, her husband, do hereby grant and convey in fee simple unto the said Benjamin P. Crampton all the following described land and premises situated in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland containing Four and one fourth acres of land more or less, together with all and singular the buildings, improvements, rights, ways, privileges and appurtenances thereto belong or appertaining and being the same land conveyed to a certain Martha V. Crampton by deed executed by Peter Rhodes and wife dated April 12th 1864 and recorded in Liber J. N. L. C. No. 1 folio 692 one of the Land Records of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, and which the said Martha V. Crampton conveyed to Mary E. Crampton by deed dated April 8th 1881, and recorded in Liber A. F. No. 3 folio 510 one of said Land Records of Frederick County and which was devised to the said Mary G. Brown formerly Mary G.
