1st This Respondent admits the facts stated in the Petitioners 1st 2^d & 3^d Paragraphs to be true as therein stated

2. This Respondent states that on the 3^d day of March 1883, Charles W. Ross as Trustee paid to this Respondent Cyrus A. Font the sum of Six hundred and Eight dollars and five cents - that said sum was deposited to the joint credit of said Trustee in the First National Bank of Frederick and has remained there ever since - that this Respondent & the said Cyrus A. Font as Trustee in No 4919 Equity sold a certain portion of Real Estate belonging to said Trust estate for the sum of \$725 - and that by the Audit made and ratified in said cause on the day of May 1884, the payment of the Costs and Expenses, there remained the sum of five hundred and twenty five dollars and seventy three cents belonging to said Trust estate - that this Respondent so far as the first mentioned sum is concerned desired to invest the same in property for the benefit of Mrs. Jenny Ruple
