In the name of God, Amen.  
I, Felina W. Frazier of Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland, being of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, do make and publish this my last will and testament, in manner and form following, that is to say,

First and principally, I Comit my soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the earth to be properly buried, at the discretion of my executor, hereinafter named, and after my debts and funeral charges are paid, I devise and bequeath as follows:

All my estate both real and personal to be equally divided among my four Children viz. Luther F. O. Frazier, Rosella Virginia Jones, Lola May Duwall and Fannie Washington Waite, in equal portions share and share alike.

Should either of my above named Children die before the execution of this my will then their share to be equally divided among the Children of the deceased heir, (should they have any), and if dying without Children, then their said share or shares to be equally divided among my surviving Children.

And I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Luther F. O. Frazier and my son in Law Wilbur N. Duwall, to be the executors of this my last will and testament revoking and annulling all former wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming the same and none other to be my last will and testament.
