Main then with the line of said deed reversed three bounds and distance (3) north 40. and 1/8 degree east 8 and 8/100 perches (4) north 48 and 1/2 degree west 64/100 perches (5) north 38 degree east 3 and 7/10 perches to the beginning of said deed from Brill and wife to Main it being at the end of 4. and 8/10 perches on the fifth line of the deed aforesaid from Morrison and wife to Brill and with said line (6) South 49 and 1/2 degree east 1. and 38/100 perches then still with the lines of said deed these Courses (7) north 51 and 1/2 degrees east 1. and 57/100 perches (8) South 35 and 1/2 degree east 12 perches (9) South 57 and 1/2. degrees West 3 and 83/100 perches then by lines to include lots number sixteen and seventeen two Courses (10) South 44 and 7/8 degree East 6 and 74/100 perches (11) South 44 degree West. 11 and 1/2 perches to the beginning containing one acre and five eights of an acre of land more or less; also all that lot or parcel of ground designated as lot number six with all the improvements and appurtenances thereto belonging situate and lying in that part of the Village of Knoxville aforesaid known as Rhoden addition to Knoxville excepting one tract of the well of water on said lot which belongs to Mrs. Violetta G. Dotter the owner of lot number five" she to have free access and use of said well of water by being at the half the expense of keeping up the necessary repairs of said well lot No. Six being the same lot which Henry C. Brill obtained from Browning and Margaret his wife by deed the 11th day of April in the year 1859 and recorded in the Lands of Frederick County, aforesaid in Liber D. S. F. No. 4. folio 210 etc. as by reference thereto will appear and all being the same real estate as described in the deed from Herman S. Brill deced. to John Reid dated August 5th. in the year 1875. and recorded in Liber N. F. No. 1. folio 229 one of the land records of Frederick County, Maryland, and being part of the same real estate as devised by said John Reid to his wife Elizabeth Reid by his last will and testament which is found duly recorded in Liber H. L. No. 1 folio 2409. one of the Records of wills in the office of the register of Wills for Frederick County, Maryland and which said real estate described unto the said J. Frank Reid and Mary C. Flood and J. Brian Reid as the Children and heirs at law of said Elizabeth Reid who died intestate and the said J. Frank Reid and Mary C. Flood being the heirs at law of said J. Brian Reid who died intestate to above and to hold the said real estate unto him the said Otterbridge Torrey

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
