Raymond L. Frizzell, Leonie M. Frizzell his wife, Ira C. Frizzell, Mary H. Frizzell, his wife, Walter H. Frizzell Marie Frizzell his wife, complaining say:-

1st - That Mary H. Frizzell, deceased, was in her life time and at the time of her death, seized and possessed in fee simple, of the following described tracts or parcels of real estate situate in Frederick County, Maryland, to-wit: First, all that tract or parcel of land described in a deed from Am. H. Beall and wife to Mary H. Frizzell, containing fifty two acres of land, and recorded in Liber M. N. N. No. 5, Folio 218, one of the Land Records for Frederick County, a Certified Copy of which deed is filed herewith and marked exhibit No. 1, which together with all other exhibits Complainants pray may be taken and considered as a part hereof. - Second, All that tract of land of which Basil Harding did seized and possessed and described in a Certain deed from Samuel Gleason and wife to said Basil Harding duly recorded in Liber C. S. No. 4, Folio 71, a Certified copy of which deed is filed herewith and marked exhibit No. 2, to this Bill, of which property the said Mary H. Frizzell, took as sole heir at law at the death of the said Basil Harding, said tract containing one hundred and four acres of land.

Third - All that tract or parcel of land of which Margaret H. Harding did seized and possessed, and which descended to upon her death to Mary H. Frizzell, deceased as sole heir at law, which will be found described in a deed from Michael H. Hammond, and wife, to the said Margaret H. Harding containing 3-1/2 Sq. - ft., and recorded in Liber J. L. J. No. 1, Folio 87, a Certified copy of which deed herewith filed and marked exhibit No. 3, to this Bill of Complaint. Fourth - All that tract or parcel of land of which Margaret M. Harding did seized and possessed, and which descended to Mary H. Frizzell, deceased at her death as sole heir at law, which will be fully described in a Certain deed from Isaac Nusser, et al. to said Margaret H. Harding duly recorded in Liber H. J. F. No. 13, Folio 588, a Certified Copy of which is herewith filed and marked exhibit No. 4, to this Bill of Complaint:
