To the Honorable, the Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity.

The Bill of Complaint of Isaac S. Bowers respectfully represents unto your honors:

1st. That on the twenty first day of February A. D. 1907. Isaac F. Bowers, late of Frederick County, State of Maryland, died intestate. Seized and possessed of certain real estate situated lying and being in Frederick County, State of Maryland, died intestate. Brough his wife to the said Isaac F. Bowers, bearing date the fifth day of October A. D. 1866, duly recorded in Liber J. W. L. Co. No. 4. Folio 388 one of the land records of Frederick County, a Certified Copy of which is herewith filed, marked Exhibit No. 1. to this bill of Complaint and the other deed from Joseph M. Keay, and wife to the said Isaac F. Bowers, bearing date the 21st day of March A. D. 1901. a duly Certified copy of which is also herewith filed as part hereof, marked Exhibit No. 2. to this bill of Complaint.

2. That the wife of the said Isaac F. Bowers died some time before his death and at the time of his death there survived him only the following children and heirs at law to whom the said real estate descended as tenants in common and who are now seized and possessed of the same, viz:

- (1) Isaac S. Bowers a son whose wife is dead, an adult over twenty one years of age who resides in Indiana County, State of Pennsylvania.
- (2) Martha E. McNulty a daughter whose husband's name is Patrick E. McNulty both adults over twenty one years of age and both reside in Frederick County State of Maryland.
- (3) Susan Struggs, a daughter, whose husband
