

- 1 That a decree may be passed for the sale of said real estate.
2. That the proceeds of said sale may be distributed among the parties thereto entitled according to their respective rights and interests,
3. That a trustee may be appointed for said sale and distribution.
4. And for such other and further relief as the nature of this case may require.

And your Oratrix prays the following process.

That your Honors may grant unto your Oratrix the order of publication giving notice to the said above named non-residents heirs of the object and substance of this Bill and warning each of them to appear in person or by solicitor, in this Court on or before some day certain to be named therein to show cause if any or either of them may have, why a decree ought not to be passed as prayed. And as in duty bound etc.,

At the request of Hiram Stottlemeyer the following Deed was recorded Feb, 12th. 1874,

This Deed made this 9th day of October, in the year Eighteen hundred & Seventy three by Mary Toms of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland Witnesseth!- That in consideration of four hundred and fifty dollars the said Mary Toms do grant unto Hiram Stottlemeyer of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, all the following described real estate situated in Hauvers District, and being part of a tract of land called "Three Mill Seats" and being described as follows- Beginning for the same or first parcel at the end of Seventeen perches from a white oak stump & on a certain line of a deed from Miller to One Mersan, then with said line South $52\frac{1}{2}$ ° East 64 perches South 66 ° East $44, 13/20$ perches North $19\frac{3}{4}$ ° East-75 perches North 70 West-60 perches South 51 ° West 66 perches to the place of beginning containing $33 \frac{20}{160}$ acres, of land more or less in fee simple, Beginning for the second parcel at the end of 17 perches on the first line of certain May Bidle deed and running thence with said Deed 2 courses South 53 ° East 46 Perches South 29 ° West 18 Perches, North 68 ° West 28 Perches North 13 ° East 32 perches to the place of beginning containing $6 \frac{4}{160}$ acres of land more or less in fee simple.
