My Name is William D.L.Harne, I reside at Garfield Frederick County, Maryland, I am 48 years of age, I knew all the parties to this case, I knew H,E,Kuhn, who is deceased, but I do not know his widow, nor do I know the names or ages of his children, I knew Denton Kuhn in His Life time, he is dead he died a number of Years ago, the exact date I do Not Know, as far as I know he died intestate, he left surviving him a widow, Ann R, Kuhn, and the Followin children, A, Scott Kuhn, a son whose wifes name is Emma A, Kuhn Laura L, Wolfe, a daughter whose husbands name is, is Roman Wolfe, Cora D, Hays, a daughter whose husbands name is Mathew Tracy Ann I, kuhn, a son, whose wifes name is Jennie Kuhn Chester Kuhn a son whose wifes name is Bessie kuhn, and H,E,Kuhn A son, I did not know E,E,Kuhns wife, nor do I know of the ages or names of his children, ann R, kuhn The Widow of Denton Kuhn is dead, she died sometime in February 1919, the exact date of which I do not know, I understand from Current Reports, that H,E,Kuhn a son of Denton Kuhn is dead, He died out west, and as far as I know he died intestate, I understand he lived in the State of Illinois,

I knew That Denton Kuhn was seized and possessed of a small tract of land, situated near Garfield, Frederick County, Maryland, I Knew this tract of Land, which consists of about, ten or eleven acres of land, I look at Exhibit A, which is a copy of a deed from Jeremiah C, Forrest Trustee, to Denton Kuhn which to the best of my knowledge correctly describes this property, The Property is Not in very Good Shape, and I think it would be worth about \$500,00 It is not susceptible of Division among the parties in interest, without loss and injury, and it would be to the interest benefit and advantage of all the parties especially to the infant Children of H.E.Kuhn to have it sold, and the proceeds divide,

My Name is Ira Lewis, I reside at Garfield, Frederick County, Maryland, I am 45 years of age, I know all the parties to this cause, I Knew H,E,Kuhn in his lifetime, he is dead, but I do not know his Widow nor do I know the names of his children nor their ages. he has been dead 15-or 16 years, as far as I know he died intestate, he left surviving him a widow Ann R, Kuhn, and the following Children A, Scott Kuhn a son, whose wifes name is Emma Kuhn Laura A, Wolf, a daughter whose husbands name is Roman Wolfe, Cora D, Hayes, a Daughter, whose husband name is Cyrus D, Hay minnie L, Tracy a daughter whose husbands name is Mathew Tracy Ann I kuhn a son whos wifes name is Jennie kuhn, Chester kuhn a son whose wifes name is Bessie Kuhn and H,e,Kuhn A son Ann R kuhn th widoe of Denton Kuhn. is dead she died sometime in February last 1919, the exact date of which I, do not know, I understand from Current reports that h.E,Kuhn a son of Denton Kuhn is dead, he died out west. and so far as I know died intestate, I have heard it said that they had three children,

I knew That Denton Kuhn in his life time was seized and possessed of a small tract of land, situated near Garfield, Frederick County, Maryland, I knew this tract of land, which consists of about ten or eleven acres of land, I look at Exhibit A, which is a certified copy of a Deed from Jeremiah C, Forrest to Denton Kuhn. which to the best of my Knowledge correctly describes the property, to the best of of my knowledge the property is worth abot \$500-or 600 it is not susceptible of division among the parties in interest without loss and injury, and it would be to the interest and advantage of All the parties in interest to have the same sold and especially to the infant Children of H,E.Kuhn to have the proceeds divided amongst the infants, and all parties in interest.
