The above cause standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted, the Bill, Answer, Exhibits testimony and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered .

It is thereupon, this 29th day of July in the year nineteen hundred and Twenty-two by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and by the authority of said Court, adjudged, ordered, and decreed, that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold, and that George R.
