That the property and premises mentioned in Exhibits Nos. 1 and 2, cannot be divided among the parties in interest without loss and injury and it would therefore be to the interest benefit and advantage to all the parties to this cause that said property mentioned herein be sold and after the payment of the costs and expenses and the mortgage debt mentioned in Exhibit No. 3, that the remainder be divided among the parties hereto according to their several rights and interests.

Wherefore Your Complainant prays.

(A) That the property mentioned and set forth in this Bill of Complaint may be decreed to be sold and after the payment of the costs and expenses attending said sale and the payment of the mortgage indebtedness, the proceeds remaining be distributed among the parties hereto according to their respective rights and interests.

(B) That your Complainant may have such other and further relief as the nature and Equity of the case may require.

This Deed made this Ninth day of October in the year Eighteen hundred and Ninety four by Ulysses C. Frushour and Catherine R. Frushour his wife, of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth:- That in consideration of Eight hundred Dollars we the said Ulysses G. Freshour and Catherine R. Freshour his wife do grant unto Anna L. Renner of Frederick County and State of Maryland in fee simple all that part of the parts of tracts of land called part of Ungerland and part of Mad Bottom situate and lying and being in Lewistown Election District of Frederick County and State of Maryland, Beginning for the same at a stone at the North east corner of John Sheely's one acre three Rods and twenty perches of land conveyed to the said John Sheely by Charles E. Freshour and wife and running thence N. 17° W. 33-3/10 perches to a marked Elm Tree thence 50½° E. 4-6/10 perches to a stone thence with a line of fence as the same now stands N. 75° 30-70/100 perches to a stone on the North side of a small branch and at the end of 2-05/100 perches on the 7th line of the whole farm as the same was surveyed by Wm. H. Hilleary on the 7th of December 1887 and running by and with the line of said survey reversed S. 39° E. 2-05/100 perches to a stone S. 26¼ 0/4 E. 28/100 perches to the
