Your Orators, complaining, say;-

1st. That your Orators, Annie P. Hedges, John W. Hedges and Annie F. Hedges, John H. Staley and Glenna Staley, are residents of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland. and John Hedges and Belle Hedges, are residents of Baltimore City, in the State of Maryland; Louisa Vanmeter is resident of Jefferson County, in the State of West Virginia; Ella R. Buxton and William L. Buxton are residents of Montgomery County, in the State of Maryland. Oscar R. Hedges and Idella C. Hedges are residents of Poweshiek County, in the State of Iowa; and Minnie M. Allen is resident of Miami County, in the State of Kansas;- and that the defendant, Elmer Berriker, infant, is resident of Baltimore County, in the State of Maryland.

2nd. That Gideon M. Hedges, a resident of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, died in Frederick City, in said County and State, on or about the date April 16th, in the year 1923, intestate, unmarried, and without any child, or descendants of a child, and the father and mother of the said Gideon M. Hedges also, then being dead.

3rd. That, at the time of his death, the said Gideon M. Hedges left surviving him as his only relatives and next of kin, your Orators, Annie P. Hedges, a sister; John W. Hedges, a brother; Louisa Vanmeter, a sister; Ella R. Buxton, a sister; John H. Staley, a nephew, he being the son of Mary J. Hedges, a deceased sister of said Gideon M.
