Nelson I direct that the said sum of five thousand (\$5000.00) dollars shall be given unto Mrs. Sallie Englar, daughter of the said Jeannette M. Nelson, and wife of Samuel Englar, now residing in Baltimore City, Maryland, as her absolute property and estate, -

I give and bequeath unto David Cramer, son of John D. Cramer, deceased, of Frederick County, Maryland, the sum of two thousand (\$2000.00) dollars, -

I give and bequeath unto Mrs. Ada Cramer, wife of Ezra Cramer, and daughter of John D. Cramer and Anna-belle Cramer, deceased, of Frederick County, Maryland, the sum of two thousand (\$2000.00) dollars;

I give and bequeath unto William C. Cramer, son of John D. Cramer and Annabelle Cramer, deceased, of Frederick County, Maryland, the sum of two thousand (\$2000.00) dollars, -

I give and bequeath unto Emma Worman, daughter of Mary Worman and William Worman, deceased, and now residing at Harmony Grove, Frederick County, Maryland, the sum of two thousand (\$2000.00) dollars;

I give and bequeath unto Annie Worman Thomas, daughter of Mary Worman and William Worman, deceased, and now residing in Frederick, Maryland, the sum of two thousand (\$2000.00) dollars, -

I give and bequeath unto Willia Worman, daughter of Mary Worman and William Worman, deceased, and now residing at Harmony Grove, Frederick County, Maryland, the sum of two thousand (\$2000.00) dollars;

I give and bequeath unto the "Evangelical Reformed Church of Frederick," a corporation, located at Frederick, Maryland, of which at this time Reverend Henri L.G. Kieffer is the Pastor, and a record of the incorporation of which body corporate is found in "Church Record," folios 145 etc, one of the Records in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, the sum of five thousand (\$5000.00) dollars, - and I request that the Pastor and Consistory, the governing body of said corporation will invest said sum of five thousand (\$5000.00) dollars, and apply the income or interest arising therefrom for the benefit of the poor members, or those who are poor and connected with said Church, the said the Pastor and Consistory in their official capacity to be the sole and final judges as to who will be their beneficiaries of said income, - the above request of said Pastor and Consistory not to be construed as mandatory or binding on them, but merely expressive of my preference as to what purpose said income or interest shall be applied, it being my intention, and I so give, that the said sum of five thousand (\$5000.00) dollars, and any and all interest or income arising therefrom will be the absolute property and estate of said Corporation to use the principal thereof in any manner or for any purpose it sees property as its own property and estate;

I give and devise unto Belle Scholl, Mary H. Scholl, Charles Scholl and David Scholl, children of William H. Scholl and Elizabeth E. Scholl, deceased, all of my undivided one-half right, title, interest and estate which I have in and to that farm containing 69 acres of land, more or less, situated in Frederick County, Maryland, and being the same real estate as described in the Deed from Thaddeus M. Biser, Trustee, to Edward A. Shriner and Margaret E. S. Hood, dated March 19th. 1895, and recorded in Liber J.L.J. No. 7 Folio 684 etc, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, -

I give and bequeath unto Abram Kemp Keefer, and Jacob Rohrback, of Frederick, Maryland, the sum of six thousand (\$6000.00) dollars, in trust nevertheless, for the purpose of investing and reinvesting the same, and annually paying the net interest or income arising therefrom unto Matthias Bartgis Scholl, now residing in Baltimore, Maryland, for and during the time of the natural life of the said Matthias Bartgis Scholl, and after his death I direct said Trustees to pay two thousand (\$2000.00) dollars thereof unto his children of Margaret Jane Kehne of Bethalto, in Madison County, Illinois, equally, share and share alike, and two thousand (\$2000.00) dollars thereof unto Helen Scholl Hersperger of Frederick, Maryland, and two thousand (\$2000.00) dollars thereof unto S. Scholl Rutherfords, now residing at Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, -
