

Keller Lime Company, a corporation duly organized under the Laws of the State of West Virginia wherever situate within the jurisdiction of this Court, including all the plants, machinery, offices, office furniture and fixtures, and all other buildings and the contents thereof, all supplies, tools, equipment, and materials, and property of every kind, real and personal, owned, held, possessed or controlled by said corporation, together with all other property in connection therewith and all moneys, invoices, choses in action, credits, bills receivable and accounts receivable, bonds, stocks, leasehold interests, operating contracts, and other assets of every kind and all other property and rights of every description held or possessed by it, to have and to hold the same as the officers of and under the order and direction of the Court.

The said receivers are hereby authorized and directed to take immediate possession of all and singular the property above described whether situated in said State of Maryland or under the jurisdiction of the Court.

And the said The O.J.Keller Lime Company, and each and every of its officers, directors, agents, and employees, are hereby required and commanded forthwith to turn over and deliver to such receivers of their duly authorized representatives, any and all books of account, vouchers, papers, deeds, leases, contracts, bills, notes, accounts, money, or other property in its or their hands. The said Receivers are hereby authorized to collect or under its or their control, all debts due said corporation of every kind.

And said receivers are directed to deposit the moneys coming into their hands in some bank or banks in the City of Frederick, in the State of Maryland, and to report their selection to the Court. Said receivers are hereby fully authorized and empowered to institute and prosecute all such suits as may be necessary in their judgment to the proper protection of the property and trusts hereby vested in them and likewise defend all actions instituted against them as receivers and also to appear in and collect the prosecution or defense of any and all suits or proceedings now pending in any courts against said corporation, the prosecution, or defense of which will, in the judgment of said receiver be necessary and proper for the protection of the property or rights placed in their charge, and for the interest of the creditors and stockholders of the said corporation. The said receivers before proceeding to act as such are hereby required to give bond in the penalty of Fifteen Thousand Dollars with corporate security to be approved by the Court, or the Clerk thereof conditioned for the faithful discharge of their duty, and the said receivers are required to make and file full reports in this Court. And the Court reserves the right, by orders hereinafter to be made, in all respects to regulate and control the conduct of said receivers.
