

surviving a son, named Thomas M. Danner, who is also deceased, he having died intestate about thirty years ago and left surviving the following children: a son, named Thomas Danner, Jr.; a daughter, Ida Danner; a son, named Ray Danner; and a daughter, named Catherine Danner Riggles, all of whom live in Frederick, Maryland. George T. Danner was also survived by a daughter named Addie Hunt, who lives in Balrimore, Maryland. He also had a son by the name of Charles Danner, who died intestate about 1914, leaving surviving two daughters, named Gladys Albaugh and Myrtle Jacobs, both of whom live in Frederick County, Maryland, between Ladiesburg and Woodsboro.

George T. Danner was married twice, and his second wife's name was Flora M. Danner, and she is still living and resides at Brunswixk, Maryland. By the second marriage they had a daughter named Lillie M. Moler, whose husband's name was Edgar Moler, both of whom are now dead, Lillie Moler having died about nine years ago prior to the death of Thomas L. Danner, intestate, leaving surviving a son, whose name is Kenneth Moler and who lives at Baltimore, Maryland. George T. Danner also had a son by the second marriage named W. Edward Danner, who died intestate about 1920 and left surviving a son named Charles E. Danner, who lives at Brunswick, Maryland. George T. Danner was survived also by a daughter, named Daisy Gibbons by virtue of his second marriage, whose last known address was Baltimore, Maryland. George T. Danner was further survived by a son, named Harvey L. Danner; a son, named Albert H. Danner; a son, named Andrew L. Danner; a son, named Harry W. Danner; a daughter, named Edna Danner; a daughter, named Mabel Barger, all of whom live at Brunswick, Maryland; and a further daughter, named Helen M. James, whose last known address was Baltimore, Maryland.

Thomas L. Danner also had a brother by the name of William Perry Danner, who died intestate in 1935. His wife's name was Carrie Danner, and she predeceased her husband. William Perry Danner was survived by a daughter named Lena M. Deaner, who lives at Knoxville, Maryland, and he also had a son named Joseph H. Danner, who was unmarried and died intestate January 6, 1936.

Q. Can you state whether or not all of the heirs of Thomas L. Danner, which you have just related, are more than twenty-one years of age?

A. Yes, sir, a lot of them are over fifty.

Q. When did Mrs. Anna Danner, wife of Thomas L. Danner, die?

A. She died on December 11, 1935.

Q. Did she leave a Will?

A. Yes.

Q. I show you a copy of Will filed in this proceeding as Exhibit "No. 3". Will you look at it and say whether or not that is a true copy of Mrs. Danner's Will?

A. That is her Will. Charles Magalis and John N. Marquette renounced in favor of me.

(Exhibit "No. 3" filed with Examiner as evidence.)

Q. You have been appointed Administrator c.t.a. of the estate of Anna Danner by the Orphans Court for Frederick County?

A. Yes.

Q. Have you completed the administration of her personal estate?

A. Yes.

Q. To whom did Mrs. Danner leave her estate?

A. To her sister, Sarah Marquette; a brother, Franklin Garber; and another brother, Samuel K. Garber.

Q. Are all of these parties now living?

A. All except one; Mrs. Marquette's deceased.

Q. When did Mrs. Marquette die?
