TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Bill of Complaint of Nettie B. Stockman and Harvey A. Stockman, her husband, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:

FIRST: That a certain Mary R. Greenwald died in the year 1938, intestate, leaving as her heirs at law, in whom the hereinafter described real estate vested, as tenants in common, the following children, namely:

C. Myrtle Greenwald, unmarried, a daughter, who resides in Frederick County, Maryland

all of whom are adults and the only parties in interest.

SECOND: That at the time of her death the said Mary R. Greenwald was seized and possessed in fee simple of a tract of land situate, lying and being near Feagaville, Frederick County, Maryland, containing fourteen acres, more or less, and improved with a dwelling house and other outbuildings, it being the same parcel of land which was conveyed to Mary R. Greenwald and James B. Greenwald, her husband, by deed from Wilson Greenwald, dated November 17, 1920, and recorded in Liber No. 333, folio 371, a certified copy of said deed is filed herewith marked Exhibit No. 1 to this Bill of Complaint and it is prayed the same may be considered a part hereof.
