I, Henry Stottlemeyer, residing near Utica, in Frederick County, Maryland, do hereby make, publish and declare this my last will and testament, in the manner and form following, that is to say:

After the payment of my debts and funeral expenses, I do hereby give, devise and bequeath as follows:

1. To my son Franklin H. Stottlemeyer, my mantel clock with wooden works in it.
2. To my wife, Effie Irene Stottlemeyer, all of my personal property absolutely, and all of my real estate for and during her live, and after her death I give, devise and bequeath said real estate as follows:
 - a. The 140 acre farm known as the Summers Farm, to my daughter, Alta Irene Hubbard, for and during her life and then to her children in equal shares absolutely.
 - b. The other farms known as the Home Farm and the Brengle farm containing 179 acres, to my son Franklin H. Stottlemeyer, for his life and then to his children, in equal shares.
3. In the event of any one interested in my estate filing a caveat to this will or taking any active steps toward contesting the same shall receive the sum of five dollars and nothing more from my estate and the share given to any such person, shall become a part of the residue of my estate and be divided amongst my heirs in equal portions.

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my said wife to be the Executrix of this my last will and testament to serve without bond.
